Her article has been published in the book "Namma Naduvina Sadhakaru, Belli Anchu- Silver Lining". She is the Curator, Producer and Artistic Director of Annual Grand event "BEYOND BORDERS INTERNATIONAL FESTIVAL OF CLASSICAL DANCE AND MUSIC" which is a prestigious platform for prominent artists. She is also on the panel of judges and award committee for various National and International level dance competitions in Singapore and India. Vidushi Dr. M.S.Srilakshmi is a multifaceted personality. She began exploring Bharatnatyam at the age of 6, learning the basics of the dance form such as various hand gestures, facial expressions, and footwork. After her initial years of formal training, Nikita continued to learn more advanced aspects of the art from 2018 onwards under the guidance of Vidushi Dr. M.S.Srilakshmi, an accomplished Bharatanatyam dancer and performer. Under her guidance, Nikita has performed at various platforms and events, such as Salam India, Expo events, ancient temples around Singapore, and many more. She also competed in the International Classical Dance competition organized by ICMDA (International Carnatic Musician and Dancers Association), India, winning the Bronze medal in the senior solo performance category.

Apart from dancing, Nikita enjoys singing and performing music. She underwent her basic training in Indian Carnatic and Hindustani vocals under gurus from India as well as Singapore. She also enjoys playing the piano, having been formally training since the age of 8. Nikita is a student of NPS International School Singapore and is starting Grade 10 this year.

Nikita excels academically and in her extra-curricular activities, particularly in the area of public policy debate; the Model United Nations is among her favourite platforms to express her viewpoints on Global Co-operation and International Welfare. She is a vivid reader who also indulges in writing, having published a few articles in her school newspaper. Ramanan started learning mirdangam at the age of 12 from the late Sri R Thangavelu of Kuala Lumpur. In 1981, he joined SIFAS and studied under the loving care of Sri Karaikudi R Krishnamurthy. Ramanan passed his mirdangam final examination conducted by the Society in June 1984 with distinction and was awarded a certificate of merit. He had his mirdangam arangetram in 1984 during the concert of Sangeetha Kalanidhi Sri T V Sankaranarayanan. Over the past 40 years, Ramanan has performed with many accomplished musicians and dancers both locally and abroad, including providing mirdangam accompaniment for more than 400 Bharatanatyam arangetrams.



Lazar Thurakkal Sebastine - Violin

Shri. Lazar started his professional life as a performer and teacher in 1991. His father, Late Shri. Sebastine Thurakkal, a well-known violinist himself, laid a very strong foundation in music. Shri Lazar joined R L V college of music & Institute of Fine Arts, Tripunithura in 1984 for a 4-year diploma course in music and scored 1811 rank in Kerala state for violin. He then pursued a 3 year post graduate diploma course in 1991. Shri. Lazar is a graded artist with All India Radio & Doordarshan, and was an instructor with Singapore Indian Orchestra & Choir People's Association Singapore. He is working as a tutor in Centre For the Arts National University of Singapore. He has composed music for tele films, devotional albums, contemporary & classical music albums. Besides being an accomplished violinist, he is also adept at playing Keyboard and has knowledge in Western Classical music.
