

Otium Privacy Policy

Effective July 4 2025

Otium (“we,” “us,” or “our”) is committed to protecting your privacy. This Privacy Policy explains how we collect, use and safeguard your information when you access our website or use the Otium platform during its beta phase.

By using Otium, you agree to the practices described below.

1. What Information We Collect

We may collect the following types of information when you use Otium:

- Contact Information: such as your email address when you create an account
- Identifiers: such as a user ID associated with your account
- Location Data: such as your general (such as city or region) location to provide relevant local recommendations
- Usage Data: including interactions with the app such as searches, clicks and saved activities
- Diagnostics Data: including crash logs and performance data to improve app stability

We do not collect precise location data. We collect only the information necessary to provide and improve the service.

2. How We Use Your Information

We use the information we collect to:

- Improve the Otium platform and user experience
- Provide and operate the app’s core functionality

- Personalize recommendations and results
- Improve and optimize the performance of the app
- Respond to feedback and suggestions
- Communicate with you (e.g., product updates or beta announcements)
- Monitor usage and diagnose technical issues

We do not sell your personal data or share with third parties for advertising or tracking purposes.

We may use trusted third-party service providers (such as hosting, analytics or authentication services) to help operate the app. These providers only access information as necessary to perform their functions and are not permitted to use it for other purposes.

3. How We Share Information

We may share anonymized or aggregated data with service providers or partners that help us operate, analyze and improve the product.

We do **not** share your personal information with third parties for marketing or advertising purposes.

4. Data Linking and Tracking

Some data collected (such as email address, user ID and usage data) may be associated with your account.

We do not use your data for cross-app tracking or targeted advertising, and we do not share your data with third-party advertising networks.

5. Cookies and Analytics

We may use cookies or similar technologies to track usage and improve functionality. You can adjust your browser settings to disable cookies if you prefer, though the site may not work optimally.

6. Your Rights and Choices

You may request deletion of your account and associated data at any time.

Within the app, you can:

- Delete your account directly from the Privacy and Data settings page

Alternatively, you may request deletion by contacting us at: emma@otiumfindsfun.com.

When your account is deleted, we will permanently remove your personal data, except where retention is required for legal or operational purposes.

7. Data Retention

We keep your information only as long as needed for the purposes described in this policy, or as required by law.

8. Security

We use standard security measures to protect your information. However, no online platform is completely secure, so please use at your own discretion during this beta period.

9. Children's Privacy

Otium is not intended for children under 13. We do not knowingly collect personal data from children.
