

CHECKLIST FOR SURGERY DAY - Mouth Sx

- o MVSS Surgical Consent Form completed, found at MVSS.info
- o Record vitals on CONSENT form then,
- Email consent to MVSSforpets@gmail.com
- o Confirm pet is fasted
- o IV catheter placed
- o IV fluids. 5-10 ml/kg/hour during surgery if no underlying disease.
 - o If cardiac disease begin at 1-2 ml/kg/hr
- o Anesthesia recommendations
 - o Premedication-
 - Cerenia 1mg/kg IV slow or SQ *Highly recommend for Brachycephalic patient.
 - +/- Dexamethasone-SP 0.25 mg/kg IV at induction
 - Choose 1 analgesic
 - Hydromorphone 0.1-0.2 mg/kg
 - Morphine 0.25-1.0 mg/kg IM or SQ (canine only)
 - Buprenex 0.02 mg/kg (higher dose for advanced sx)
 - Midazolam or Diazepam 0.1-0.2 mg/kg
 - Other Sedatives IF needed and young/healthy
 - Acepromazine 0.02 mg/kg IV
 - Dexdomitor 1/4 IV dose
 - $\circ\;$ Induction agent: Choose most comfortable protocol
 - Propofol 4-6 mg/kg to effect only
 - Alfaxalone 2mg/kg dog, 5 mg/kg cat to effect only
 - Ketamine/Midazolam or Diazepam
 - o Gas anesthesia
- o Antibiotics (HOLD until culture sample obtained in surgery)
 - o Cefazolin 22 mg/kg IV Concentrated 100mg/ml for IV dose (9.6ml Sterile Water)

OR

- o Ampicillin 22 mg/kg (Prefer) given IV
- Sedatives POST OP if needed to prevent excessive panting, excitability, or barking
 - o Acepromazine 0.02 mg/kg IV Or
 - Dexdomitor ¼ IV dose

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Please have these items out and readily available before we arrive, this helps us to be most efficient and extend our care to more patients per day

- o **Surgical prep** supplies ready at prep area
 - Items to keep patient warm: Socks for feet, towels, hot water bottles. *Most heat is lost during prep time*
 - o Designated surgery clippers or Clean/new blade
 - o Exam gloves
 - o Chlorhexidine solution, non-sterile bowl to dilute
 - o Gauze and Cotton tipped applicators (non-sterile)
 - o +/- Chlorhex scrub and alcohol gauze (premade is fine)
- o **Operating room** supplies ready in OR

*Please be sure to remove clutter and unneeded equipment from the OR

- o Extra Towels (not sterile) 3-4 for floor and positioning
- o Surgical gloves, size 6.5
- o Surgical gowns
- o Bottle of 70% Isopropyl Alcohol
- o Chlorhexidine scrub 4%, we will supply if you do not have
- o Saline bottle preferred (or bag of IV fluids) NEW/UNopened
- o Surgical Pack (general or spay is fine)
- o Sterile bowl w/gauze (can be clean dog bowl sterilized)
- o Scalpel Blade #10 and #15, one of each
- o Suture- (generic okay)
 - PDS on taper needle, sizes vary 0, 2-0, or 3-0
 - Monocryl on reverse cutting needle, 3-0 or 4-0
 - Nylon on reverse cutting needle, 3-0 or 4-0
- o Sterile Syringe 12cc; Needles- 21 gauge, 22-20 gauge 1.5in
- o **E-collar** (hard and plastic) to go home
 - o Must be at least 1" past nose when cone pushed down neck
- \circ **Medications** to go home
 - o Antibiotics-
 - Amoxicillin 30 mg/kg BID for 2 weeks OR
 - Clavamox 13.75 mg/kg BID

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- o NSAIDs for 2 weeks, if appropriate (no steroids or medical conditions)
- o Gabapentin 10 mg/kg every 8-12 hours for 7 days
- o Sedative if pet is very excitable or anxious
 - Acepromazine or Trazadone (do not use w/Tramadol)
- o Discharge papers and ICEPACK for client
 - o MVSS to provide via email in addition to YOUR office discharge
