

Creating Awareness

620,000 Canadians have mobility related disabilities







Problem

In 2012, there was an estimated 3.8 million individuals with a disability in Canada, 288,800 (8%) used a wheeled mobility device.

10% of the latter reported an unmet need for additional devices.1

In 2017 the number of people with a disability rose by approximately 40% to 6.2 million.

Extrapolating from the 2012 report it can be assumed that 10% of the 2017 number also have unmet needs for additional devices.

COCIETY WHEELCHAIRS

Problem

- Wheelchair manufacturers need to consider the specific needs of an individual, how they move, and the activities in which they need and want to engage in.
- Those with mobility issues might also require (or desire) multiple devices to enable different activities and facilitate access to different environments.
- Wheelchair design and seating effects every aspect of individuals lives, from posture, pain and pressure management to mental, social health and well being to achieving excellence through sports.
- Bridging the gap between client and artisan to ensure client satisfaction.
