



## LCC EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP

### **Applicant Eligibility**

#### Merit-Based Scholarships

- Active members of LCC in good standing, and who will be enrolled in an undergraduate or graduate degree program by September 1, 2024 of the 2024-25 academic year.  
(*Un-enrolled Members-student may apply, but should be accepted to university/college by December 1, 2023 in order to be considered.*)

- Students who expect to have eligible academic expenses not funded by other scholarships or grants.
- Applications and all other materials received by December 15, 2023 @ 11:59pm.

#### Need-Based Scholarships

[ ] *Optional.* Up to 7 extra points are awarded. Also, if you are the first in your (immediate) family to attend university, you are also encouraged to apply for 'Need-Based' points.

In 250 typed words or less, explain why LCC should consider you [your situation] as a 'special' need-based applicant. Be direct, show how without special consideration, the likelihood of you attending university/college would be diminished. Also, show how you have been preparing to meet the financial needs associated with furthering your education.

- Active members of LCC in good standing, and who will be enrolled in an undergraduate degree program by December 1, 2023 of the 2024-25 academic year.
- Students who expect to have eligible academic expenses not funded by other scholarships or grants.
- Applicants who demonstrate financial need and submit all information provided and/or requested.
- Applicants with applications and other materials received by the December 15, 2023 application deadline.

\* *Need-based applicants with complete applications will be considered for both merit-based and need-based scholarships.*

### **Additional Applicant Requirements**

- Applicants can seek outside support with proofreading and application review. However, applicants are required to complete the scholarship application process on their own behalf.
- As a condition of the application, applicants understand LCC will not communicate with third parties, including parents, regarding application status.

### **Scholarship Uses**

At the discretion of the student.

### **CATEGORIES**

1. Character – An overall view, integrity, dedication, set-backs, infractions and lessons learned, etc.
2. Community Service – volunteering; Greek/social organization, etc.
3. Grades – Grade point averages
4. Leadership – Demonstration of skills, and participation.
5. Honor, award, etc. – Your accomplishments, recognitions, etc.
6. Impact – As a result of degree, impact on the world, difference-maker, etc.
7. Essay – Include the use of scholarship, impact, a brighter tomorrow, giving-back to community, etc.

They have detailed and thorough descriptions of their roles and accompanying responsibilities for each activity listed, and their descriptions reflect involvement over a consistent and a steady period of time with demonstrated excellence throughout.
4 (=25 points)	Good	The applicant has provided clear evidence of a well-rounded variety of activities that reflect their commitment to leadership, Scholarship, and service. They have detailed descriptions of their roles and accompanying responsibilities for each activity listed, and their descriptions reflect involvement over a consistent period of time.
3 (=20 points)	Acceptable	The applicant has adequate evidence of a variety of activities that reflect their commitment to leadership, scholarship, and service. They have provided adequate descriptions of their roles and accompanying responsibilities for each activity listed, and their descriptions reflect involvement over a relatively consistent period of time.
2 (=15 points)	Poor	The applicant is lacking evidence on a variety of activities that reflect their commitment to leadership, scholarship, and service. They have not provided detailed descriptions of their roles and accompanying responsibilities for each activity listed, and their descriptions reflect involvement over an inconsistent period of time.
1 (=10 points)	Very Poor	The applicant has little to no evidence of a variety of activities that reflect their commitment to leadership, scholarship, and service. They have lackluster descriptions of their roles and accompanying responsibilities for each activity listed, and their descriptions do not reflect strong or consistent involvement.
