Advanced Driving School is happy to be your driving school. We promise to give you all the tools you need to become a successful driver. Our program fee is \$700.00. The fee for the classroom portion is \$350 and the fee for the drive portion is \$350. The classroom must be paid in full the saturday prior to the start of the first class. The driving fee is due on the first driving lesson. Refunds will be made upon request before each session is started. Once a session is started no refunds for that session will not be given.

The program consists of -

30 hours of classroom 12 hours of driving 6 hours of observation 2-hour parent class

The program must be completed within a two year period.

There is a \$30 fee for all returned checks.

All lesson cancellations must be done by text (preferred) or call to 774-404-5553. Cancellations with less than a 24 hr notice are subject to a \$45 fee. If you are not at your appointed time or place for a lesson you will be subject to a \$45 no show fee. If you do not have your permit or proper footwear (no flip flops because

they are dangerous to drive or work boots because they are too big) you will be subject to a \$45 fee. All fees must be paid prior to the next lesson.

Any students who damage school property or harass school personnel will be immediately expelled without a refund. This will include swearing, spitting and slamming car doors)

Students will be eligible to book a road test upon the completion of the program and six months of having a permit. Upon completion of the program there is a \$15 fee (which the rmv charges us) to certify a student.

Private lessons are available for a fee of \$45 per hour.

Instructors may arrive 15 minutes early or late for an appointment. It is very difficult to predict the exact time of arrival due to traffic, weather, ect.

Any missed classes must be made up at the same time in the next available class. Classes are held once a month. As per RMV rule, every parent must take a parent class before a student can start driving with us. If you have taken a class within the last five years we need a copy of the certificate.

If you choose, you may use our car for your road test. The fee to go to the Plymouth RMV is \$125. We will go to Taunton, Braintree and Brockton for an additional fee. Road test fees must

be paid one week in advance and are not refundable. We strongly suggest you prepay the road test fee (\$85) to the RMV in advance.

The RMV requires parents to practice driving with their children for a minimum of 40 hours before they can go for a road test. WE CANNOT EMPHASIZE THIS ENOUGH, 40 HOURS IS THE BARE MINIMUM. YOU SHOULD PRACTICE WITH YOUR CHILD AS MUCH AS POSSIBLE.

To book driving lessons we follow a simple process. Every friday each student who wishes to drive must text their availability for the following week. Please use the following set up.

All texts need to be received on Friday. Texts received on Saturday and Sunday will not be considered unless there is availability or cancellations in the schedule because the schedule is done early Saturday morning.

Your child will learn to do 3 point turns, parallel parking, backing 50 feet and hill stops. Please practice these with your children. It's very important to practice everything we teach. We need to work together to make your children the best drivers they can be.

Covid Procedures

Due to the current Covid situation the RMV has made changes to their current policy.

The RMV is now providing cars, free of charge, for the road test. Every car is sanitized between road tests. Only RMV and driving school cars are to be used for the road test.

Instead of six hours of observation with the driving school the parent is now responsible for an additional six hours of driving. There is an additional paper required (which we will provide) for parents to fill out.

The RMV also requires students to bring their own pen to sign the drive in log. Students are not allowed to share pens.

Only one student is to be in the car at all times. This is making it very hard to provide as many lessons to as many students as possible per day. This only allows us to pick up five students each, per week, at the high schools. We currently work with five high schools so you can see how difficult this is. For as much as possible all driving lessons will start and end at Advanced Driving School. Please do not park in the small parking lot on the side street next door to the school. It is private property and we have been asked not to park there.
