Please ensure that you attach wires so that the painting can hang close to the wall so it doesn't slant outwards. Hanging point should be about 2.5 inches below the top of the picture.

Please deliver your artwork on time on Thursday April 6, 2023 at 10:00 so that the hanging can be done as quickly as possible.

The artwork is changed approximately every 3 months.

SPACE: The "art wall" space is separated by "pillars". As a result, there are 3 separate (but adjacent) areas along the length of the one wall.

Two of the areas measure approximately: 8.5 feet wide x 4.5 feet high.

The third area measures approximately: 5.5 feet wide x 4.5 feet high.

ANOTHER SPACE HAS OPENED UP IN ADDITION TO THE ABOVE:

This area measures approximately 8.5 feet wide x 4.5 feet high.

I suggest popping down to the coffee shop to see the layout.

DISPLAY TIME: Work will be displayed for a month at a time.

It is up to artists if they wish to take all the space, or if they would like to share the space.

Generally your time will start at the beginning of the month and will end at the end of the month. I have left these times flexible and will help co-ordinate the taking-down and hanging times between artists if necessary.

HANGING YOUR WORK:

PLEASE HANG/TAKE DOWN YOUR WORK AFTER 4PM.

There will be a hammer, nails and sticky-tac available to use.

(Sticky-tac for labels).

If you need help, please let me know and I can help you if I am available.

BOX OF CARDS: You may include a small box of greeting cards.

SMALL ORIGINALS & PRINTS: You may bring a box of small prints and/or originals.

SALES: The owners will handle all sales and take a 20 percent commission on all sales.

Please leave an inventory of your work with Helen and Dianne so they can mark off any sales.





Sheila Symington Lifetime Membership Award

The SSWRAS Executive recently voted to change the name of our Lifetime Membership to the "Sheila Symington Lifetime Membership Award." Sheila, who passed away in April 2022, was a founding member of the Painters Workshop (established in 1959) which was the organization that evolved into the South Surrey & White Rock Art Society. Over the years Sheila played a key role in supporting the organization, not only as an active member, but also by serving on what became the Executive in many capacities, including President more than once. But her greatest contribution, along with latemember Kay Jenkins, was likely the founding and running of the White Rock Summer School of Art.

For more than 10 years, Sheila coordinated a series of summer workshops, bringing in renowned painting instructors from all over Canada and the U.S. For 10+ years, the Summer School afforded an opportunity for hundreds of artists of all skill levels the chance to learn and experience painting techniques in all media. Students traveled from as far away as Florida and New Brunswick to attend a workshop. Through her efforts, thousands of dollars were raised for the Society's building fund, allowing us the chance to have our current home at the South Surrey Rec & Art Centre. She was not only an active member of the SSWRAS, she was also an incredibly talented and prolific artist, a signature member of the Federation of Canadian Artists and a signature member of the Northwest Watercolor Society.

Sheila's daughter Kathy, who accompanied her mother to our 65th Anniversary Gala celebration in December, 2019, wrote:

"What an honour to have the Lifetime Membership renamed after mum. We know the contributions she made to the art community and I think she would be proud to know her name will live on. Please let the SSWRAS know the family appreciates this recognition.



"I remember well the [gala] that I took her to in December 2019. [While] I thought this was just another show that she would enjoy seeing, she was acknowledged as the 'Grande Dame of the SSWRAS.' It was as much a special evening for me as it was [for] mum. She had received the Surrey Civic Treasure award for her fund raising for the new art centre, but it's the first time I personally had seen her recognized by the SSWRAS. I still have the picture of her [from the Gala] and I display [it] on my fridge. It reminds me of how happy I was to have shared that day with her.

"Thank you also for kickstarting the retrospective art show after her passing." -Kathy

In addition to being honored in memoriam with our Lifetime Membership, Kwantlan College which receives an annual art-student scholarship from our Society has named that scholarship in Sheila's memory.

For those who never had the pleasure of knowing Sheila, just know that the SSWRAS is what it is today thanks to her contributions and those of many, many others who loved art and believed in its vital importance as a presence and influence in our world.
