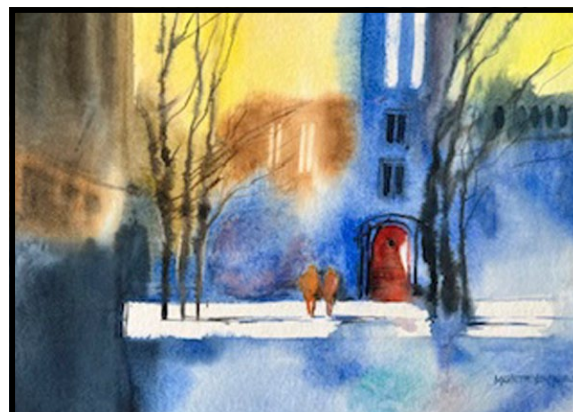

Bio: Alice is a well-respected Canadian watercolour artist based in Harrison Hot Springs, BC. She is a member of the Federation of Canadian Artists (FCA) and IWS Canada, and a board director of the Canadian Society of Painters in Watercolour (CSPWC-SCPA). Her work has been exhibited nationally and internationally. Alice has given painting demonstrations at international exhibitions in Hungary, Poland, and France. In 2026, Alice will lead a team of 19 artists representing Canada at the Fabriano In Acquarello International Watercolour Exhibition in Italy. Alice paints in a fresh, loose, impressionistic watercolour style, with an emphasis on spontaneity, light, and atmosphere. She is passionate about teaching and enjoys working with artists at all levels.

Description: Alice will guide participants through the process of creating expressive landscape/seascape/and cityscape paintings using photo references she provides. Over the course of the classes, attendees will complete two projects while learning a clear, step-by-step approach to watercolour painting. Each session includes demonstrations and instruction focused on simplifying a scene to create a strong composition, establishing value and colour structure, using wet-in-wet techniques to create mood and atmosphere, developing a strong centre of interest and managing paper wetness and timing to achieve desired values. Alice will explain both the how and the why behind each step, sharing her thought process as she paints. Emphasis is placed on individual artistic development, with practical guidance to help participants paint more effectively and with greater confidence.

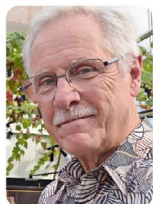

CALL FOR ARTISTS

TO CELEBRATE INTERNATIONAL ARTIST DAY 2026

INTERNATIONAL ARTIST DAY (IAD) is a special date dedicated to honoring artists and their contributions to society. The global celebration recognizes the impact of art and the creative minds behind it. Because art—be it through music, photography, painting, dance or any form—captures the essence of the human experience: the joys, sorrows, struggles, and hopes. The day celebrates artists who bring these expressions to life through their work.

Did you know that White Rock is the official world home of IAD? The City of White Rock has provided the Uptown Gallery space in Central Plaza, White Rock, for the month of November as a venue for this year's International Artist Day celebration. Chris MacClure, the founder of IAD, is calling upon artists interested in participating in a group showing that celebrates IAD 2026, to be part of this show.

A large portion of wall space has been dedicated to showcase a "small introduction" show for local artists. Up to 3 pieces of art can be entered per artist, at \$5 per submission. The image must not exceed 144 sq.in., may be framed or unframed, must be ready for hanging and the retail price should not exceed \$300. 15% will be deducted on any sales to cover expenses and refreshments and advertising.

To engage public interest and attendance there is an anticipation of participation by artists showing work to be present in the gallery on certain occasions to discuss their process with the public.

Please note the following:

- Maximum size 16" height x 20" width; smaller if in a glass frame.
- Attach wires so that the painting can hang close to the wall without slanting outwards.
- Bumpers must be attached on the back bottom two corners.
- Title and Artist's name must be on the back of all paintings.
- Artist is responsible for dropping off and picking up their art, which should not be removed during the 4-6 month period other than when a painting has sold.
- Artist must sign a release form before dropping off their painting. No exceptions. If someone other than the artist is dropping off the painting, then you will need to give them permission to sign the release form on your behalf and let the coordinator know ahead of time.
- Information for labels (title, medium, framed size, price, artist's name, and phone number) is to be sent to

the coordinator a week or so ahead of the scheduled installation. Labels will be made by the co-ordinator.

Neither Oceana Parc Playhouse nor the Art Society are responsible for damage or loss, although every effort will be made to ensure its safety.

WHEN A PAINTING SELLS:

Playhouse takes 20% Artist receives 80% of the selling price. The interested buyer will contact the artist directly. Please contact Sandy or Adam if your painting has sold or it needs to be removed and we will make arrangements with the playhouse to set up a time for that. Please do not contact the Playhouse directly. PST is to be paid for all paintings sold through the Art Society.

The buyer is to give a cheque made out to "South Surrey White Rock Art Society" or e-transfer for the full amount (including PST) to the Society treasurer. The treasurer then writes a cheque to the playhouse for 20% and the artist for 80%. There is no replacing the paintings once they are sold.

Important:

The Playhouse has asked that all artwork have bumpers on the back bottom two corners to ensure that the walls don't get marked up. You can use felt pieces for under furniture and cut them to fit if you don't have the ones specifically for frames. Artwork without bumpers will not be accepted. Please ensure that you attach wires so that the painting can hang close to the wall so it doesn't slant outwards. The hanging point should be about 25 inches below the top of the frame.

Please deliver your artwork on time on Wednesday January 21, 2026, at 2 PM so that the hanging can be done as quickly as possible. All hanging will be overseen by the coordinators.

Once the Label information has been received, there will be a confirmation email going out from Cheryl Vandenberg within 48 hours and will include a copy of the release form to print & sign

If the member cannot deliver or pick up their painting then they will have to have someone else deliver or pick up at the set time, letting our hanging committee know ahead.

PLEASE NOTE: GROUPS OF ARTISTS ARE WELCOME TO SHOW THEIR WORK, but will be allocated 1 month to do so.

SPACE: The “art wall” space is separated by “pillars”. As a result, there are 3 separate (but adjacent) areas along the length of the one wall.

TWO OF THE AREAS: measure approximately:
8.5 feet wide x 4.5 feet high

THE THIRD AREA: measures approximately:
5.5 feet wide x 4.5 feet high

PLEASE GO TO THE PELICAN ROUGE AND LOOK AT THE SPACE BEFORE YOU MAKE ANY HANGING PLANS.

DISPLAY TIME: Work will be displayed for a month at a time.

It is up to artists if they wish to take all the space, or if they would like to share the space.

Generally your time will start at the beginning of the month and will end at the end of the month. I have left these times flexible and will help co-ordinate the taking-down and hanging times between artists if necessary.

HANGING YOUR WORK:

PLEASE HANG/TAKE DOWN YOUR WORK AFTER 4 PM.
This is by the owners request.

There will be a hammer, nails and sticky-tac or masking tape available to use for labels. It is kept behind the counter. *Ask Diane or Helen for it.*

If you need help, please let me know and I can help you if I am available.

BOX OF CARDS: You may include a small box of greeting cards.

Make a record of how many cards you have and leave this at the shop.

Mark each cards one price (eg. \$5) - NOT 5 for \$20.00

SMALL ORIGINALS & PRINTS: You may bring a small shoebox size of small prints and/or originals.

LEAVE YOUR BOX OF ORIGINALS, PRINTS & GREETING CARDS IN THE COFFEE SHOP FOR THE MONTH FOLLOWING YOUR DISPLAY.

FOR EXAMPLE: If you display in April, you may leave your items for the month of May.

SALES: The owners will handle all sales and take a 20% commission. Leave an inventory of your work with Helen or Dianne so they can mark off any sales.

LABELS: Please create your own printed label and include:

Title / Medium / Size / Price.

We need the following APPROXIMATE sizes.

If you have smaller work, let us know the size we will do our best to accommodate it.

Paintings with glass can be no larger than 16 x 20"

- 6 paintings - 20" height x 16" width (including frame) – max size or slightly smaller
- 5 paintings - 24" x 24" – max size or slightly smaller
- 6 paintings - 30" x 30" – max size or slightly smaller
- 1 paintings - 36" width x 48" height – max size or
- 3 paintings - 36" height x 48" width max size or slightly smaller

1. Work will be displayed for 6 months at a time.

2. Artists are responsible to drop off and pick up their art.

Artists must sign a release form when paintings are brought to the venue – no exceptions. The release form will be available for signing at the venue.

3. Insurance of individual pieces will be at the artist's discretion.

4. All hanging will be overseen by the co-ordinators

5. Information for labels is to be sent to the co-ordinators a week or so ahead of the scheduled installation. Labels will be made up by the co-ordinators and must include:

ARTIST'S NAME

TITLE OF PIECE

MEDIUM

SIZE

PRICE

ARTIST'S CONTACT INFO

(email, phone or however you would like to be contacted).

6. Interested buyers must contact the artist and arrange payment. THE CLINIC WILL NOT HANDLE ANY PAYMENTS.

Once a purchase has been made, a co-ordinator will meet the artist at the clinic and hand over the painting.

PLEASE DO NOT TAKE WORK DOWN WITHOUT A CO-ORDINATOR PRESENT.

7. Because this is not considered an official White Rock South Surrey Art Society Outside Venue, artists do not have to pay commissions.

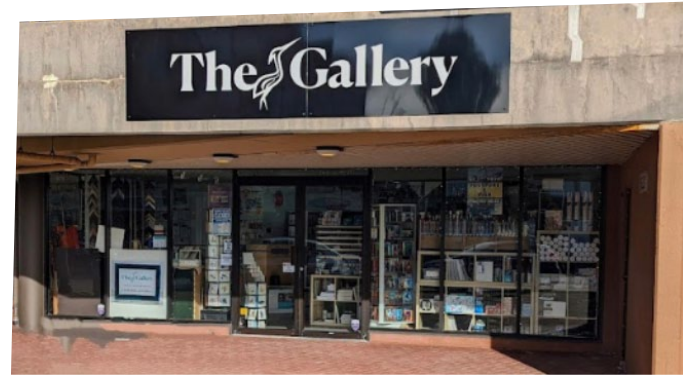

The Sweetness of Life: this is 1 of three 18th-Century French Paintings from The Frick Collection

Jules and Edmond de Goncourt, the eminent 19th-century historians of French art and society, baptized the 1700s the “century of women.” Though 18th-century women did make strides in the sciences, literature and the arts, they were most often portrayed in genre scenes pursuing leisurely, quotidian pleasures and tasks. Three superb 18th-century French genre paintings from The Frick Collection in New York, part of an ongoing reciprocal exchange program, are on view this summer at the Museum. These artfully constructed visions of contemporary life and fashion, as depicted by François Boucher, Jean-Baptiste Siméon Chardin and Jean-Baptiste Greuze, provide viewers with an intimate look at the lives of middle-class French women of the 1740s and 1750s. The paintings will be installed in the Museum’s 18th-century Rococo gallery among its own works by Chardin and Boucher, as well as paintings by Jean-Antoine Watteau and Jean-Honoré Fragonard.

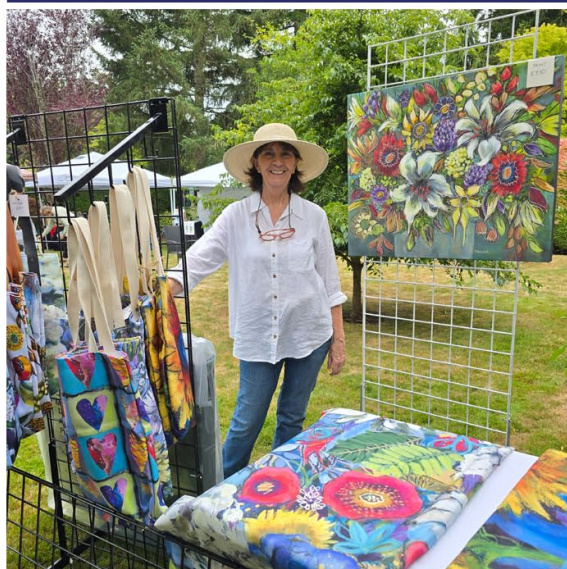
