In this Demo:

In Ciel's work with The Federation of Canadian Artists, she is a juror and speaker. In this demo Ciel will share her insights of what goes into the creation of an interesting image. Ciel describes that 'Often we focus exclusively on the techniques of painting and overlook the decisions that happen before the paint hits the canvas. As two-dimensional artists, we all have the same limitations and opportunities. How can we best use the tools and techniques we have to draw our viewers in to consider what we are creating? Artistic style, composition, canvas size and orientation, subject matter, perspective, leading lines, and Notan are all valuable tools at our disposal.



Using her own images to demonstrate these concepts Ciel will invite participants to ask questions and connect with her further if they would like to dive into these ideas in more depth.

Inspired by the flowers found in the west coast gardens around her South Surrey Studio, Ciel is continually amazed by the variety of colours, shapes, and spirit of these delicious flowers and is compelled to capture them in oil paint.

While having painted throughout her life, she spent a number of years as a life coach helping others find a life they loved. Feb 2019 found her wanting the same for herself. Focusing full-time on her art was what she was drawn to do. By October 2019 she was ready for her first solo show.

Love and beauty are at the core of why she creates. Having spent a good part of her life healing from trauma and loss, painting beauty has captured her full attention. Knowing that others are also trying to find their way, it is her hope that her love-inspired flowers help others find their way to more peace in their own lives.

Did you know that you can now register for Thursday Night Classes?





Important:

The Playhouse has asked that all artwork have bumpers on the back bottom two corners to ensure that the walls don't get marked up. Please add bumpers to your frame. You can use felt pieces for under furniture and cut them into small squares if you don't have the ones specifically for frames. Please ensure that you attach wires so that the painting can hang close to the wall so it doesn't slant outwards. Hanging point should be about 2.5 inches below the top of the picture.

Please deliver your artwork on time on Thursday April 6, 2023 at 10:00 so that the hanging can be done as quickly as possible.

The artwork is changed approximately every 3 months.

Please note: **GROUPS OF ARTISTS ARE WELCOME TO SHOW THEIR WORK**

SPACE: The “art wall” space is separated by “pillars”. As a result, there are 3 separate (but adjacent) areas along the length of the one wall.

Two of the areas measure approximately:
8.5 feet wide x 4.5 feet high.

The third area measures approximately:
5.5 feet wide x 4.5 feet high.

ANOTHER SPACE HAS OPENED UP IN ADDITION TO THE ABOVE:

This area measures approximately 8.5 feet wide x 4.5 feet high.

I suggest popping down to the coffee shop to see the layout.

DISPLAY TIME: Work will be displayed for a month at a time.

It is up to artists if they wish to take all the space, or if they would like to share the space.

Generally your time will start at the beginning of the month and will end at the end of the month. I have left these times flexible and will help co-ordinate the taking-down and hanging times between artists if necessary.

HANGING YOUR WORK:

PLEASE HANG/TAKE DOWN YOUR WORK AFTER 4PM.

There will be a hammer, nails and sticky-tac available to use.

(Sticky-tac for labels).

If you need help, please let me know and I can help you if I am available.

BOX OF CARDS: You may include a small box of greeting cards.

SMALL ORIGINALS & PRINTS: You may bring a box of small prints and/or originals.

SALES: The owners will handle all sales and take a 20 percent commission on all sales.

Please leave an inventory of your work with Helen and Dianne so they can mark off any sales.

LABELS: Please create your own and include:

Title / Medium / size / price. Printed is better as it's more professional.







Thank you to all the artists who submitted their beautiful pieces of art for the 2024 Art Calendar for our Fundraiser.




A committee of three SSWRAS members judged the 46 entries sent in by our 23 members. We only had 13 spots on the calendar.
