



About our Presenter

Operating his own business, Island Pine Marketing and Design, whilst still nurturing and sharing his passion and skill for drawing and painting. He is a dedicated and committed teacher who focuses on technique as he guides his students to unlock their creative potential. He has taught classes in Photoshop, drawing, plein-air landscape painting, portrait drawing and watercolour painting for both the Semiahmoo Arts Society and Fraser Valley Continuing Education as well as private tutorials.

In this demo he will give an insightful watercolour portrait demonstration. He will dive deep into a wide range of tips, techniques and materials essential for creating expressive and lifelike portraits. Key aspects will be explored such as; how to build up skin tones through delicate layering, managing effectively wet-on-wet and dry brush techniques and how to harness the subtleties of color mixing for realistic shading and highlights. Members will also learn the tricks for controlling water flow as fine details showing soft edges with sharp contrasts are achieved. This demonstration is perfect for both beginners and seasoned artists seeking to expand their watercolour skills.

About the Artist:

Perry Haddock was born in Berkeley, California, and moved to Vancouver at the age of seven. He did his schooling there, eventually doing a BA in English and a teaching degree at UBC. He later completed a Masters degree in Counselling Psychology, and retired in 2003, after more than 25 years as a counsellor in a Langley secondary school. Although he was interested in painting from early on, it wasn't until he began a teaching career that

he began to study art seriously. Following a fifteen year period as a potter, Perry turned his interest to drawing and painting, eventually teaching art in high school and pursuing his painting through college classes and workshops. He is a signature member (SFCA) of the Federation of Canadian Artists and an active member of the B.C. Art Teachers' Association. His paintings are held in private and corporate collections in both North America and Europe.

About the Workshop

As with most of Perry's workshops, his primary goal is to encourage participants to approach landscape painting with an experimental attitude and the idea that, "It's only ten bucks worth of materials. Have some fun. Colour outside the lines!" That isn't to say that painting doesn't require some knowledge of the principles of design and some discipline to apply them. However, sometimes the anxiety of thinking we have to produce a "finished product" often results in tight drawing, tight brushwork, and slavish attention to photo sources. Instead, let's aim to challenge ourselves to "loosen up." Along the way, we'll talk about composition, values, and colour as they apply to our paintings.

Perry will demonstrate his approach to working from photos, with full demos each morning, and mini demos throughout both days as participants work on their own paintings. He will demonstrate using acrylics, but oil painters are welcome, although some of the processes aren't strictly transferable.

Participants are encouraged to bring several landscape photos as references. The majority of the time will be spent painting, so make sure you have enough photos, canvasses, and snacks! (Materials list on the website.)

Bio:Tony O'Regan is a White Rock resident and a long-time member of Semiahmoo Art Society. He was born in Cork, Ireland and grew up Florida and in Canada. He graduated in Art (Hons. Painting) and Architecture (MEDes/Arch). He has taught Painting, Drawing, Sculpture and Design for over 25 years, including Shadbolt Center, Emily Carr and UBC. Tony continues to create a collection of hundreds of his demonstrations and teaching videos as well as other useful content for artists, teachers, and student portfolios at www.toregan.com

This course deals with essential skills needed to draw faces. No prior skill is assumed, while those with some skills will benefit also. Lighting and composition will also be investigated. The basics are covered using black and white mediums – mainly charcoal and/or graphite.

Session 1 - Construct the human head-form from various angles

Session 2 - Draw and shade the 4 feature groups – eyes, nose, mouth, ear, and expressions

Session 3 - Important lighting patterns, shade-shadow and tonal shapes

Session 4 - Composition and poses, Color demonstration follow-up video





Instructions for Members Hanging Artwork at

- 1. At the request of the Melissa (Hilltop Medical Clinic manager), submissions will be "lightly juried". The final choice will rest with the manager.
- 2. There is currently space available for 19 paintings at this venue.
- 6 paintings 20" height x 16 " width (including frame) max size or slightly smaller
- 5 paintings 24" x 24" max size or slightly smaller
- 4 paintings 30" x 30" max size or slightly smaller
- 1 paintings 36" width x 48" height max size or
- 3 paintings 36" height x 48" width max size or slightly smaller

Please note that the following are MAX sizes. If you have smaller work, let us know the size we will do our best to accommodate it.

Paintings with glass can be no larger than 16 x 20"

3. Work will be displayed for 4 months at a time.

Work must remain in the clinic for this time period.

4. Artists are responsible to drop off and pick up their art.

Artists must sign a release form when paintings are brought to the venue – no exceptions. The release form will be available for signing at the venue.

- 5. Insurance of individual pieces will be at the artist's discretion.
- 6. All hanging will be overseen by the co-ordinators. Artists will be asked to drop their work and leave.
- 7. Information for labels is to be sent to the co-ordinators a week or so ahead of the scheduled installation. Labels will be made up by the co-ordinators and must include:

ARTIST'S NAME TITLE OF PIECE MEDIUM SIZE PRICE

ARTIST'S CONTACT INFO (email, phone or however you would like to be contacted).

8. Interested buyers must contact the artist and arrange payment. THE CLINIC WILL NOT HANDLE ANY PAYMENTS.

Once a purchase has been made, a co-ordinator will meet the artist at the clinic and hand over the painting.

PLEASE DO NOT TAKE WORK DOWN WITHOUT A CO-ORDINATOR PRESENT.

Because this is not considered an official White Rock South Surrey Art Society Outside Venue, artists do not have to pay commissions.

PLEASE GO TO THE PELICAN ROUGE AND LOOK AT THE SPACE BEFORE YOU MAKE ANY HANGING PLANS.

DISPLAY TIME: Work will be displayed for a month at a time.

It is up to artists if they wish to take all the space, or if they would like to <u>share the space</u>.

Generally your time will start at the beginning of the month and will end at the end of the month. I have left these times flexible and will help co-ordinate the taking-down and hanging times between artists if necessary.

HANGING YOUR WORK:

PLEASE HANG/TAKE DOWN YOUR WORK AFTER 4 PM.

This is by the owners request.

There will be a hammer, nails and sticky-tac or masking tape available to use for labels. It is kept behind the counter. *Ask Diane or Helen for it.*

If you need help, please let me know and I can help you if I am available.

BOX OF CARDS: You may include a small box of greeting cards.

Make a record of how many cards you have and leave this at the shop.

Mark each cards one price (eg. \$5) - NOT 5 for \$20.00

SMALL ORIGINALS & PRINTS: You may bring a small shoebox size of small prints and/or originals.

LEAVE YOUR BOX OF ORIGINALS, PRINTS & GREETING CARDS IN THE COFFEE SHOP FOR THE MONTH FOLLLOWING YOUR DISPLAY.
