## **Fun With Alcohol Inks**

### **About our Presenter**

Elayne's artistic journey began about 5 years ago when she tried watercolor. She has since been inspired by others to try different mediums & explore a variety of subjects, especially west coast landscapes, flora and fauna. Her artwork pieces encompass watercolor, acrylic, alcohol ink, mixed media, oil & pastel. She is mostly self-taught through video tutorials but has also learnt from in-person workshops & courses. Elayne belongs to several art guilds/councils showing her work at local galleries in Langley, Surrey, & Delta.

Elayne will be demonstrating how alcohol Inks can produce vibrantly coloured paintings and can be used on a variety of non-porous surfaces such as plastic paper, glass, metal and specially treated canvas. However, they do pose some challenges for artists due to their quick evaporation, instant reactivation of layers and their ability to flow.

In this demo, Elayne will: list supplies needed to get started, use air to move the ink around, demonstrate painting techniques with a variety of tools that might surprise you, and review methods to preserve and seal your masterpieces! She will encourage us to have some fun playing with alcohol & alcohol inks but warns you can't drink them!







PLEASE GO TO THE PELICAN ROUGE AND LOOK AT THE SPACE BEFORE YOU MAKE ANY HANGING PLANS.

**DISPLAY TIME:** Work will be displayed for a month at a time.

It is up to artists if they wish to take all the space, or if they would like to <u>share the space</u>.

Generally your time will start at the beginning of the month and will end at the end of the month. I have left these times flexible and will help co-ordinate the taking-down and hanging times between artists if necessary.

#### **HANGING YOUR WORK:**


