June 30 BEAR CREEK PARK at 140th St (140St and 86A Ave) 9am

Another chance to dish up something great for our SAG show!!

- From WR, drive north on King George Blvd, right on 88th and right on 140th. The parking lot on 140th between 140A St and 86A Ave is where we usually park, but you can choose any Bear Creek lot.
- Lunch around 12 beside the 140th St parking lot.

July 7 SENDAL GARDENS 20210 50th Avenue, Langley

A lovely garden in a residential neighborhood. Very pretty.

- From WR or SS, drive north on 200th Street, watching for the sign for Sendal Gardens. A short drive on 50th brings you to the parking lot.
- Good washrooms, and a choice of lunch locations.

July 14 DEREK DOUBLEDAY ARBORETUM 21177 Fraser Hwy, Langley

A new location! It's an open, sunny park with access to local trails.

- This park is on Fraser Highway just a short way East of 200th Street. It is on the North side of Fraser Highway and offers free parking and nice washrooms.
- Lunch location: TBD

July 21 REDWOOD PARK. 17900 20th Avenue, Surrey

A plein air standard! This glorious park challenges and inspires.....

- from 168th Street, drive east on 20th avenue until you see the gates of Redwood Park. There is plenty of parking and modern washrooms

July 28 PORTAGE PARK 4964 204th St. Langley

An enticing plein air site in a quiet residential area of Langley.

- travel north on 200th Street, go right on 53rd Avenue and right again on 204th

August 4 DUNSMUIR GARDENS 12345 Sullivan St. Surrey 9:30 am

We love it here! Flowers, vines, veggies, sunflowers, birdhouses...

- From Crescent road, watch for the abrupt turn right, shortly after the marina, into Dunsmuir gardens. Follow the dirt road and park in designated areas only.
- We will have to leave in early to mid-afternoon as we will be on a borrowed gate key.

August 11 BACKYARD VINEYARDS 3033 232 Street Langley Time: TBD

Relaxing, rural, scenic and you can buy wine!

- From 16th Avenue, go north on 232, the winery will be on your left. It is just about halfway between 16th and 40th Avenue
- They have a welcoming picnic area and washrooms and ample parking.

August 18 BLACKIE SPIT 3136 McBride Avenue, Surrey

The seaside, the trees, the birds, the distant hills...all lovely

- Park where you prefer. Our group usually meets for lunch at the picnic table area opposite the paved parking lot near the tennis club.
- This is a “spread out” location so you may not meet other painters until lunch time!

August 25 LATIMER PARK 19258 28th Avenue Surrey

A pretty park with views and a huge pond smack dab in an industrial area.

- Make your way to 192 Street via 16th or 32nd Street. Latimer Park is between 16th and 32nd on the east side of 192. It is in an industrial zone.
- Parking is good, usually, and the washrooms are decent. Our group meets at a timber board overlook with benches beside the pond.

September 1 LITTLE CAMPBELL RIVER HATCHERY 1284 184TH St. Surrey

We come here every year and we love it! An amazing pond, gazebo and miles of wildish trails.

- Drive south from 16th Ave on 184th Street. The Little Campbell River Hatchery will be on your left.
- Park opposite the Volunteer’s clubhouse. Lunch usually at the covered tables.

September 8 ART KNAPPS GARDEN CENTRE 4391 King George Blvd Surrey

We feel welcomed here and take spots among the outdoor greenhouses, plantings, and installations to paint and enjoy..

- Art Knapps is on King George Blvd north of 40th Avenue. Lots of parking and customer washrooms.
