The workshop is not medium-specific, but it might lend itself more to tidy, cleaner media for journal work, such as pencils, coloured pencils, ball point pens, fineliners and the like. For painting, if you choose, water-based paints - acrylics, gouache or watercolour might be easier for clean-up.

Bring what you want to work in (and what you can comfortably carry). If you want to both draw and paint, then bring the supports, surfaces, papers and sketchbook/journals that interest you...similarly with the various media you will use. If this will help, here is a list of supplies I always carry in my small art box:

- > small travel watercolour set, with bushes
- > .assorted graphite pencils & sharpener
- > .coloured pencils
- > .inktense pencils
- > .watercolour pencils
- > .ball point pens
- > .micron pigma (or similar) fineliners
- > .calligraphy pens
- > .glue stick
- > .scissors
- .exacto knife
- > .ruler
- > .eraser
- > .odds and sods
