

SUPPLY LIST

PASTELS:

Choose a hard box like NuPastel or choose pan pastels with Sofft sponges (No. 3 sponge applicator)

Can purchase a medium to soft box of pastels like Faber Castel, Rembrandt, Unison, etc. Soft are Schmincke, Sennelier or Terry Ludwig

PENCILS:

* General's White Charcoal Pencil

* General's Black Hard Charcoal Pencil
or Black Gouache & 0 size synthetic brush

* Pastel Pencils: Stabilo CarbOthello, Derwent, Pitt by Faber Castel, Conte. You can purchase in sets. (prices vary)

ERASER:

- Kneaded Blue Gum eraser by Staedtler at Staples

PENCIL SHARPENER:

- any type for pencils

X-ACTO KNIFE: optional

CLAIRE FONTAINE PASTELMAT

I use this pastel paper which can be purchased online at Amazon.ca

You do get a piece of this with your workshop class.

BLENDING STUMPS, TORTILLIONS:

1 small size, one larger or medium size

MASKING TAPE: 1 inch or larger, anywhere

RULER: 12 inch or smaller

SARAL TRANSFER PAPER

Saral Wax-Free Transfer paper - Amazon \$35 roll or
I can sell to you - \$3.50 for 1 ft. x 1 ft. sheet

OLD BALL POINT PEN (run out of ink) or Stylus - for tracing your art onto the sanded paper.

BACK BOARD or PLASTIC BOARD – mask your pastelmat paper onto

SMALL TOWEL – to use for wiping fingers and tools with

WET WIPES – to clean your fingers (I supply them here)

APRON - to keep your clothing clean

I Will Supply:

- 1 piece of Pastelmat sanded paper

- 1 piece of Glassine wax type paper to protect your pastel art

- 1 print outs in colour of the picture we will work on

Do not wear good clothing as pastels can stain them.

Do not eat at your desk. Always wash before you eat.

Do not blow your pastel dust. Tap your art board over the garbage bin or outside if not raining.

You can not get water on this sanded paper, it will ruin your art project.

NOTE: when purchasing pastel pencils, always purchase the largest set as they have a variety of colours in them.
