Despite that, in his 4 games played, we did learn that Clark can be an effective pitcher for us as he started 3 games on the mound, throwing 12 solid innings for us and winning his first ever start against the Mudhens (Winning a head to head battle with our former player/coach Klint who left our team to play for the Mudhens in 2024).

Now that things seem to have settled down a bit on the home front for Clark, hopefully 2025 will see a return to the field for Clark as he was sorely missed.
