From the first time I heard his fastball wiz by at our indoor sessions, to the first crack of the bat in the cages, I knew this guy was a player. Sometimes you can just tell.

Josh had one hell of a rookie season in the league slashing a preposterous .513/.783/.923 with a ridiculous 1.706 OPS. He became the first Blue Jay to hit 2 dingers in a season to go along with 3 Triples and 4 Doubles. On the mound, where he was selected as our Top Pitcher this year, he threw 33.1 innings going 3-2 with 2 saves, a team record 56 K's, 27 BB's and an ERA of 3.81.
