Congratulations! Your school has been chosen to receive a donation of locally raised ground beef. We think your students deserve good quality North Dakota beef. When you serve this beef, consider inviting the local press to promote the program.

In return for the beef, please contact the IBAND rancher circled on the inside of this brochure either by phone or email to report on how the students liked the beef, any packaging or other issues.

The purpose of this program is to give you a contact to purchase local beef for use in your school meal programs next year.

USDA Foods commodity ground beef has averaged \$3.71 per pound (SY22) in commodity dollars. Currently, it is \$4.09 with no decrease in sight. The price of locally sourced beef may be more than this but consider the value of knowing where the beef comes from.



# WHAT TYPE OF MEAT AND POULTRY PRODUCTS CAN BE DONATED OR SOLD TO SCHOOLS IN THE STATE OF NORTH DAKOTA?

The regulations allow:

a) State officially inspected productproduct bears

ND "inspected and passed" inspection legend.



- b) State officially inspected product produced under the Cooperative Interstate Shipment (CIS) Programproduct bears USDA "inspected and passed" SEND legend.
- c) Federally inspected product-product bears USDA "inspected and passed".



Your health inspector will be looking for an inspection seal on your meat. Make sure you are purchasing meat for your school nutrition program that has been inspected.
