

Apple Creek Campground

RULES & REGULATIONS

1. A campsite shall be occupied by not more than one family or one camping unit consisting of two adults and two children. Only two cars per site. There will be a charge of \$7.00 per night, per person for extra people.
2. Reservations will only be taken for three night minimum on holiday and race weekends. All holiday and race weekend will be paid in advance. No refunds for holiday and race weekends.
3. No refund or cancellations at any time. Rain checks will be issued for another stay, including the group area.
4. Please obey all playground rules! Children must be supervised by a parent. No profanity, throwing stones or sticks, or climbing outside of the play ground equipment.
5. Check-In Time: 1:00 pm. - Check-Out Time: 12:00 Noon.
6. The use of air conditioners and electric heaters are subject to an additional \$3.00 per day.
7. Children may not be left in the park without adult supervision (no exceptions). All children 6 and under must be accompanied by an adult in the restrooms and showers. No minors allowed to camp without an adult with them.
8. Quiet time is 11pm until 8am. However, at dark all children and teens must return to their parents' campsites. It is imperative that our campers respect their neighbors quiet and space.
9. Persons intoxicated or using profanity will be asked to leave the park. There will be no refund given.
10. No drugs, firearms or fireworks of any kind are allowed in the park.
11. The speed limit for all roads and trails is 5 miles per hour, starting with the 1st stop sign. All bikes must be at your campsite by dark. Motorcycles may be ridden to a campsite, but are not permitted to cruise the park. No motorized off-the-road vehicles are allowed to cruise the campground or property.
12. Our entrance is equipped with electronic operated gates. It is opened with a magnetic card which is available at check-in. \$20.00 will be charged if the gate card is not returned.
13. The pool rules are posted at the swimming pool. No food and beverages inside the pool area. No pets allowed inside the pool area. No babies allowed in the pool without swimming diapers.
14. All pets must be on a leash at all times. Dogs must be kept quiet at all times. Please do not leave unattended. Owners are responsible for cleaning up after their pets.
15. Campfires are allowed if weather permits. No outside firewood allowed.
16. Please do not litter. Place your trash in the dumpster as you leave. Please do not burn your trash in the fire pits. Do not cut, deface or damage any standing timber, plants or shrubs.
17. Please notify the office if you expect a visitor. All visitors must register in the office. Visitors may enter the park between the hours of 9am to 9pm. All visitors must leave by 11pm. Visitor fee: \$5.00 per adult, \$4.00 per child. Unregistered visitors will be considered trespassers and will be asked to leave.
18. No boats, personal watercraft, or utility trailers allowed in the park. Ask the office for location to park them.
19. All rules are subject to change at any time for the protection of the campground and its campers.
20. Please no gas or charcoal grills on the picnic tables.
21. We reserve the right to refuse service to anyone and will not be responsible for accidents or injury to our campers. We are also not responsible for loss of money, jewelry, or valuables of any kind.
22. Camping is an outdoor experience, therefore we do not give refunds or rainchecks due to discomforts of nature.
