HORSFALL HOUSE CHARITY WALK

SUNDAY 12TH JUNE 2022

INFORMATION FOR WALKERS

CHECKING IN: All walkers must sign in at the official checkpoint at The Library in Minchinhampton (next to the school in Bell Lane) between the hours of 9:30am and 1:00 pm and if you plan to do the full walk, return to this checkpoint when you complete the walk. The Library will remain open until 5:00pm to welcome back people who have completed the walk.

PARKING: Parking will be available in the Bell Lane car park and will be clearly sign-posted.

ROUTE: Our charity walk has been specifically selected for its variety and interest giving walkers the opportunity to go through areas not normally available to the general public. These areas include the stunning woodland of Gatcombe and the beautiful waterside gardens at Avening Court.

The full walk is a 10 mile circular route and a detailed map is provided. If you prefer a shorter walk of around 7 miles, there's a new more direct route signed back to Minchinhampton via Nags Head Lane (at Avening Court). And finally, a shuttle bus will be taking in Avening Social Club, Avening Court and Bell Lane Minchinhampton if you are ready for a lift.

TERRAIN: The terrain is mixed with well used paths, public rights of way, limited sections of public roadway, private pathways, stiles, slight to steep inclines and in some places, potholes. You should be aware that it may be muddy and uneven in places. **Please note the walk is not suitable for buggies, pushchairs or toddlers.**

EQUIPMENT: Well broken-in walking boots/sturdy shoes are recommended, as is a waterproof jacket. Any extras you may need are best carried in a small ruck-sack.

REFRESHMENTS: Avening Social Club will be open for refreshments (and toilets), bacon rolls with a veggie option and cake.

DOGS: Our walk is dog friendly, but dogs must be kept on short leads in Gatcombe Wood and the Estate and Avening Court. Any dog mess should be disposed of in appropriate bins. All other litter should be taken home with you.
