On the Fifth Day of Christmas, follow Riding Far on your favorite (or all) of your social media platforms. Riding Far is the company Paul Haefner and his son share. Remember Paul? He did our sports psychology seminar last year. Paul and his son, Justin, are always sharing tips on horse and human psychology that will enhance your feed.

On the Sixth Day of Christmas, join MY Facebook group called Powerful Equestrian Partnerships. I share posts from all over about how to make the most out of the horse/human relationship and up level your riding.
