



Wood and Epoxy Table

Care Instructions

Cleaning the Wood Surface

- Dust regularly with a soft, dry cloth or microfiber duster to prevent dirt buildup.
- For deeper cleaning, use a wood cleaner made specifically for furniture. Avoid using all-purpose cleaners as they can dull the finish over time.
- Wipe up spills immediately with a clean, damp cloth. Don't let liquids sit on the wood surface.
- Never use abrasive cleaners, scouring pads, or furniture polish sprays as these can scratch and damage the wood.

Caring for the Epoxy Surface

- Use placemats or coasters to prevent scratches, heat marks, and water rings on the epoxy surface.
- Clean the epoxy with a mild soap and water solution. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- Dry the epoxy thoroughly after cleaning to prevent water spots.
- Don't place hot items directly on the epoxy as it can scorch or discolor the surface.

General Care

- Use felt pads on the bottom of the table legs to prevent scratches on floors.
- Avoid exposing the table to direct sunlight for extended periods to prevent fading or discoloration.
- Lift the table when moving it rather than dragging it across floors.

By following these simple care instructions, your wood and epoxy coffee table will maintain its stunning appearance for years to come.
