MAG Carriers requires steer tires to be replaced when the lowest point on the tire is a 5/32: all other tires are required to be replaced when the lowest point is at 3/32. Our minimums are slightly higher than the DOT. This is to ensure the tire is replaced before it becomes a problem.

I check my tires during pre and post trip inspections and at this time all of my tires meet the minimum requirements as listed above. \_\_\_\_\_(initial)

Minimum brake measurement requirement is 8mm, 12/32 if you are using the gauge MAG Carriers provided. You need to subtract 5/32 from the measurement to account for the metal lining.
