



QUALIFICATION SYSTEM – GAMES OF THE XXXII OLYMPIAD – TOKYO 2020

Boxing

Due to the suspension of the IOC recognition of AIBA, all aspects of all boxing competitions, including but not limited to any and all qualifying competitions or events for or at the Olympic Games Tokyo 2020 shall be organised and operated under the authority of the IOC Executive Board. The Executive Board has created a special taskforce with the mandate to organise and ensure the delivery of the qualification events for boxing and the boxing tournament at the Olympic Games Tokyo 2020 and also develop a Tokyo 2020 Qualification System for boxing. The enforcement of the regulations and the qualification criteria will be the responsibility of the Boxing Task Force, the respective national federations of the sport and the NOCs in the fields of their respective responsibilities.

C. ATHLETE ELIGIBILITY

All athletes must comply with the provisions of the Olympic Charter that is currently in force, including but not limited to, Rule 41 (Nationality of Competitors) and Rule 43 (World Anti-Doping Code and the Olympic Movement Code on the Prevention of Manipulation of Competitions). Only those athletes who comply with the Olympic Charter may participate in the Olympic Games Tokyo 2020.

Age Requirements:

Athletes must be born between 1 January 1980 and 31 December 2001.

Additional Eligibility Criteria:

To be eligible to participate in the Olympic Games Tokyo 2020 all athletes (including Host Country and Tripartite Invitation Places) must:

- Participate in at least one (1) of the Olympic Qualification Events organised by the Boxing Task Force;
- Enter in the same weight category at the Olympic Games in which the athlete obtained the quota place; and
- Be examined and cleared to box by a Physician, acting under the responsibility of their respective NOCs and NFs, before (i) each Boxing Olympic Qualifications Event and (ii) the Olympic Games Tokyo 2020 as per the medical requirements set forth in *[link to be inserted]*.

Entry process for Qualification Events:

All athletes shall be entered by their respective NOC and NF in accordance with the 'Tokyo 2020 Boxing Task Force - Event Regulations' *[link to be inserted]* and comply with all abovementioned criteria.

HOST COUNTRY PLACES

The Host Country is guaranteed a total of up to six (6) Host Country Places.

These places are only available in the case that the Host NOC does not obtain any qualification places via the Continental or World qualification events, with a maximum of one (1) quota place per weight category and subject to the quota distribution as per Table 1 and Table 2 respectively, subject to the athlete meeting the Athlete Eligibility Criteria as outlined in Section C.

Up to four (4) will be available in the men’s weight categories with a maximum of one (1) Host Country place per weight category and respecting the maximum number of athletes per NOC, except for the Heavy (81 kg to 91 kg) and Super Heavy (91kg to +91 kg) weight categories where no places are available.

Up to two (2) Host Country Places will be available in the women’s weight categories with a maximum of one (1) Host Country place per weight category, except for the Middle (69kg to 75kg) weight category where no places are available.

TRIPARTITE COMMISSION INVITATION PLACES

A total of five (5) Tripartite Commission Invitation Places will be available in the men's weight categories with a maximum of one (1) Tripartite Commission Invitation Place per weight category and respecting the maximum number of athletes per NOC, except for the Light Heavy (75 kg to 81 kg), Heavy (81 kg to 91 kg) and Super Heavy (91kg to +91 kg) weight categories where no places are available.

A total of three (3) Tripartite Commission Invitation Place will be available in the women's weight categories with a maximum of one (1) Tripartite Commission Invitation Place per weight category, except for the Welter (64 kg to 69 kg) and Middle (69kg to 75kg) weight category where no places are available.

On 14 October 2019, the International Olympic Committee will invite all eligible NOCs to submit their requests for Tripartite Commission Invitation Places. The deadline for NOCs to submit their requests is 15 January 2020.

E. CONFIRMATION PROCESS FOR QUOTA PLACES

CONFIRMATION OF QUALIFICATION PLACES

The Boxing Task Force will inform the respective NOCs of their allocated quota places within three days (3) of the conclusion of the respective qualification event.

The NOCs will have two (2) weeks to confirm to the Boxing Task Force if they wish to use the quota places as detailed in paragraph G. Qualification Timeline.

CONFIRMATION OF HOST COUNTRY PLACES

Further to the conclusion of the World Qualification Event, and in case the Host Country obtains less than the four (4) male and the two (2) female guaranteed quotas across any of the weight categories, then the Host NOC will need to identify the weight categories selected for Host Country Places.

The Host NOC will have one (1) week to confirm to the Boxing Task Force the weight category for the selected Host Country Place(s).

F. REALLOCATION OF UNUSED QUOTA PLACES

REALLOCATION OF UNUSED QUOTA PLACES

If an allocated quota place is not confirmed by the NOC by the confirmation of quota place deadline or is declined by the NOC, the quota place will be reallocated to the next highest ranked athlete in accordance with the 'Tokyo 2020 Boxing Task Force - Event Regulations' [*link to be inserted*] at the respective qualification event, in the respective weight category where the quota place was obtained, respecting the criteria outlined in Section C.

REALLOCATION OF UNUSED HOST COUNTRY PLACES

Any unused Host Country Place(s), declined or not confirmed by the confirmation of quota places deadline, the quota place will be reallocated to the next highest ranked athlete at the World Olympic Qualification Event in the respective weight category.

REALLOCATION OF UNUSED TRIPARTITE COMMISSION INVITATION PLACES

If the Tripartite Commission is not able to allocate a Tripartite Commission Invitation Place, it will be reallocated to the highest ranked athlete in the respective weight category at the World Olympic Qualification Event respecting the maximum number of athletes per NOC.
