NGEN By the Numbers

We're starting March super strong. Over **185** candidates came into the system in the first week of March. At this rate, we'll triple our numbers from last year. The states with the most candidates coming into the system in February were *Louisiana, Texas, Georgia, Florida and Colorado*! This is outside of our Beyond the Yellow Ribbon partners who continue to exceed projections. North Carolina, Tennessee, California and Washington State have strong programs and we continue to work closely with our partners.
