Employment News for NGEN is evolving as quickly as the civilian markets. With headlines such as "Mass Exodus from the Workforce," "How to Combat the Resignation Tsunami" "Are workers striking?" and "Help Wanted, Where are the Workers?" it's hard to keep up.

As the pandemic recedes, it's clear it has changed the US workforce forever. In August 2021 the labor department reported 4.3 million workers QUIT the employment market and these numbers are up from previous records set in April and nearly matched in July. Workers left looking for better pay, flexible work conditions, health concerns (COVID safety) and lack of day care. The NGEN Team is working with employers and our affiliates with the ESGR and local associations like the Manufacturing Associations, Cyber markets and industrial associations to make sure we can connect our service members with great opportunities for advancement. This issue and the next few installments will focus on our training platform and partners that can help our members reskill, upskill or completely change careers. In honor of "Cyber Month" we'll focus on cyber skills/training this month.

Q. What are the best job search tips to seek an IT position?

A. Before any job search you want to think about the companies you want to work for and network with people/recruiters to assist you with getting in the door. The most popular websites for IT positions and networking are LinkedIn and Dice.com. Once you identify a job you are interested in, I recommend **always** going to the company's website to apply. This might speed up the process. Don't forget to target your resume and cover letter for any position you apply for. Training and Development

Did you know there is a need for 190,000 cyber skilled workers by the end of 2023? Cyber jobs salaries start around \$80k! Our partner **Red Hat** is providing our candidates/job seekers with VetJobs/NGEN *no cost* access to the program and the certification exam for FREE. The course has a MSRP of \$8500.

The program is completely virtual, self-paced, and the student has one year from the time they begin the program to complete it. There are two courses, approximately 40 hours each, that need to be completed along with an exam after each course. Once the student completes both courses and successfully passe the exams, they will earn their Red Hat Certified Systems Administrator credential.
