ALL POLES MUST ADHERE TO THE PROPER PROCESS AND BE APPROVED BY WREC – NO EXCEPTIONS

FEBRUARY 12-19, 2026

- Continue collecting artists submissions of drawings for consideration
- Meeting with Coastal Hernando Business Group (CHBG) to discuss sponsorships and choosing poles
- Sponsored poles – IF Business owners choose pole(s) and drawing(s) Business Owner will pay artist \$200 per pole sponsorship
- If Artist needs to purchase supplies pre-approval for purchase by Committee is required with breakdown of materials and costs. All receipts must be submitted to Diane Greenwell to be reimbursed.

FEBRUARY 23-27, 2016

- Drawings and pictures submitted to WREC for approval

Guidelines – POWER IN ART POLE PAINTING

- **DO NOT PAINT OVER SERIAL NUMBERS.** Paint up the pole to the serial number but not over the serial number. Maintain a 6' space around the ID Number
- All poles must be painted with exterior primer
- Tape off 2' above ground and measure up 6' and tape again. Pole must be painted within that 6' area and should surround pole so that from any angle there is a visual effect
- Paints must be exterior grade and should be colorful
- Poles are 17-23" diameter
- Only paint can be used. Nothing may be attached to the pole
- Submitted artwork cannot be commercial and may not include any politics or convey any controversial subject matter
- Artwork should be indicative of Hernando Beach/Weeki Wachee Preserve
- Must be colorful
- Must represent Hernando Beach and things associated
 - Scalloping, Shrimping, Crabbing, Recreational & Commercial Boats, Fishing, Dolphins, Manatees, Sand Hill Cranes, Great Herons, Pelicans, Black Bears, Snakes, Swimming, Diving, Snorkeling, Kayaking, Wild Flowers, etc.
 - Must be painted so that the painting can be seen from any angle. If you do a bird on one side It should be repeated or the surround should have fill in around it
- Drawings, photos, must be submitted to dianemgreenwell@gmail.com by January 31, 2026
- Artists may submit more than one drawing and may paint more than one pole
- Photos should be taken as the poles are being painted to include the artist at work, artist's bio, and any info artists want to share about their inspirations and emailed to dianemgreenwell@gmail.com
- Phase 1 – March 2026 – Business District of Hernando Beach – 20 poles
- Phase 2 -- TBD - May 2026 – Business District of Hernando Beach – 15 poles
- Phase 3 – TBD -June 2026 – Business District of Hernando Beach – 15 poles
