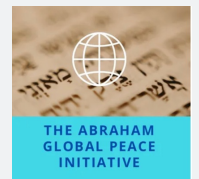

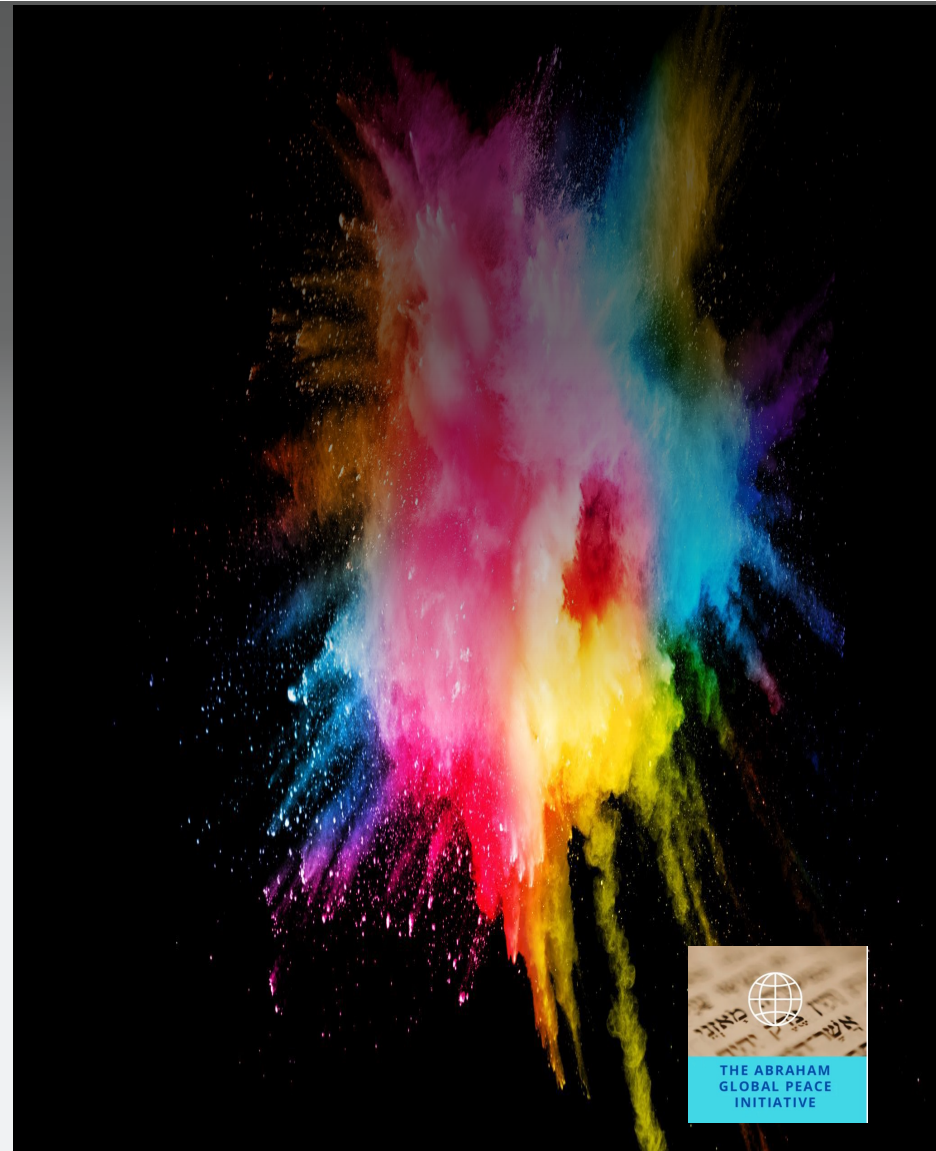

He serves as Honourary Chair of AGPI and sits on many boards including as former Chairman of RioCan (after serving there for 27 years), CargoJet, Bragg Gaming Group, among others.

The Hon. Maurizio Bevilacqua, P.C., BA, MA, LL.M was Mayor of Vaughan for 3 terms. He was an MP for 22 years as Minister of State - Finance, Minister of State - Science, Research & Development, and Chair of the Finance Committee. While he sits on the boards of many organizations including AGPI and chairs numerous initiatives, his greatest achievements are transforming Vaughan into a world-class city as well as successfully raising over \$250 million for the Mackenzie Health hospital network in York Region. Mayor Bevilacqua's Spirit of Generosity initiative has benefitted over 200 organizations whose mission is to bring about positive change to people's lives.

Richard is a serial entrepreneur and angel investor and has served on numerous boards for non-profits and other charities.

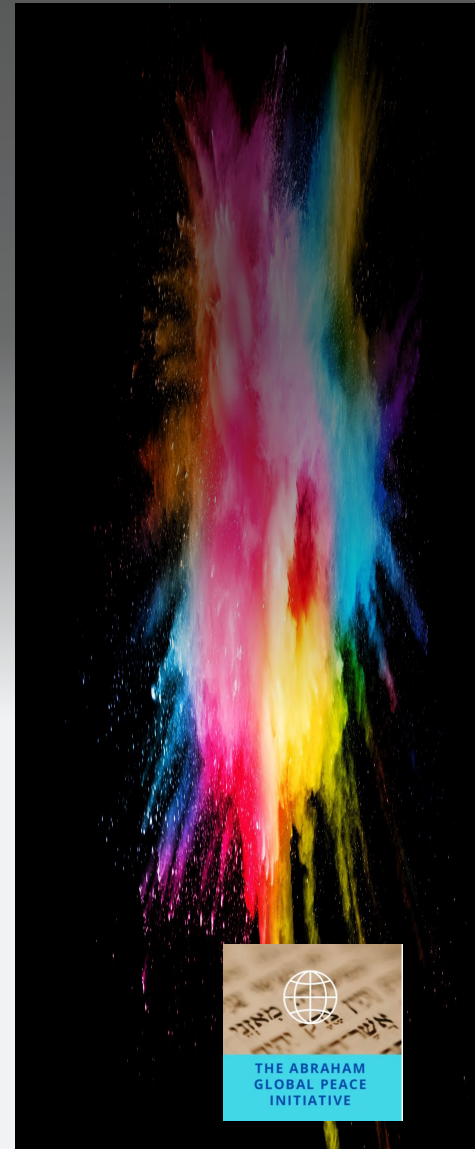
