Tony, and his late wife, Elizabeth, also received the Scopus Award from the Hebrew University of Jerusalem. In November 2009, Concordia University conferred the degree of Doctor of Philosophy (Honoris Causa) on Tony and Elizabeth.

Mr. Comper is highly regarded for co-founding Fighting Anti-Semitism Together (FAST), a coalition of business and community leaders who speak out against discrimination and who fund education programs.
