it is my pleasure to write this recommendation letter for Gabriel Singeorzan, who spent one year as a mobility student in the Master of Science programme in Building and Architectural Engineering at Politecnico di Milano, Lecco campus.

Gabriel attended my class in Sustainable Building Technologies in autumn 2022, working on a project for an energy-efficient office building in Milan. The course and its studio are developed in parallel with the Architectural Design Studio, exposing students to a simulated multidisciplinary design process. In the Sustainable Building Technologies Studio, Gabriel and his team applied the main concepts that were explained during the theoretical lectures, such as the concepts of high performance and net zero energy buildings (nZEB), the definition of green building strategies, and the design of a high-efficiency envelope, also utilising calculation and digital modelling tools to support technical decisions.

Gabriel's learning path was satisfying, as during the semester he matured the skills to correctly relate architecture and technology. His final grade was 28 out of 30.

During his two terms at Politecnico di Milano, Gabriel acquired a solid technical basis and an understanding of multi-disciplinary design processes, also supported by computational tools, aimed at the decarbonisation of the built environment. At the same time, he showed a good attitude at teamwork in the international environment of our master programme, where the majority of students come from outside Italy.
