- Care responds to real needs as they arise.

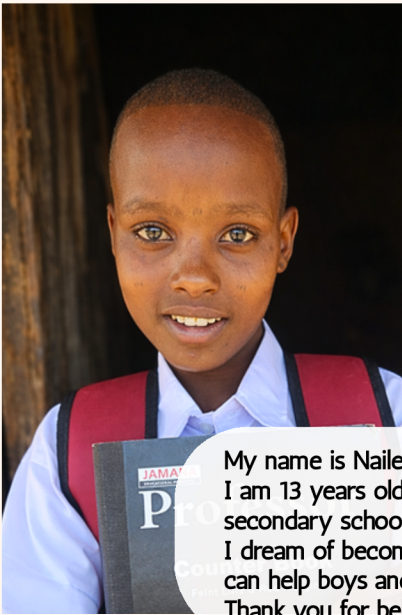
## Connection With Care

Through the Girls' Transition Support to Secondary School Program, we aim to support over 100 girls this year as they move from primary to secondary school. So far, we have encouraged and supported about 30 girls to pass their exams. We are now carefully following each girl—walking alongside her and her family—to ensure she has what she needs to begin secondary school with confidence and dignity.
