This park features panoramic views of the Okanagan Valley, looking down at Kelowna. The trails in this park are fairly gentle and pass beside the Crags – a popular rock-climbing spot. The hike will be approximately 4 km in length. There should be opportunities for some great action shots.

Details:

- 📍 Date – Saturday, June 6, 2026
- 📍 Location – We will be travelling to the Johns Family Nature Conservancy in south Kelowna, off Chute Lake Road. There is less than 1 km of gravel road to be travelled.
- 📍 Time – It is suggested that we carpool as much as possible for the drive down to Kelowna. Therefore, we will meet at the Rail Trail Parking lot at 8:00 am for a 9 am arrival at the park.
- 📍 What to bring –
 - On this outing we will be looking at some landscape vistas as well as some sporting activity. It would be best to bring lens that will provide some wide-angle shots as well as a longer lens for capturing the rock climbers.
 - As it may be warm, dress appropriately with good footwear and don't forget the sunscreen and a hat.
 - Bring along water for the hike.
