In total each two-week session you will learn over 80-120 signs that are Similar but Not the Same.

If you want to expand your ASL vocabulary and knowledge quickly or want to understand the similarities that many ASL Signs have, then this is the class for you. Each session is stand alone. You don't have to take one session to benefit from another. A common mistake made by signers is DATE vs MEET. What if you are trying to sign NICE TO MEET YOU and instead you

say NICE TO DATE YOU? Awkward.... to say the least. The only difference between these two words is the handshape. DATE is signed with a "D" handshape and MEET is signed with a "1" handshape. Another great example is INSURANCE and INFECTION. The only difference is your NMM (facial expression). You will be amazed how many signs are signed so closely but are an entirely different sign. Every class has new words. Fach session is different. The more sessions you take the more quickly you will learn nuances of ASL vocabulary.
