April 8th, 2021

The meeting was called to order by Andy Bodeen, OHAYC chapter president. Also present were chapter secretary Peg Morris, board member Art Pohl, 5 chapter members, and one guest.

Minutes of the last meeting were presented and accepted.

Tickets are on sale for the Coastal and Colvin raffles. The Coastal weapon is a Nosler; the Colvin raffle is for a 1911.

The Siuslaw clean-up project was a success. 463 tires were removed from the area. The project was coordinated by chapter member Tayler Jerome.

Thanks go to Cheryl Dollar, chapter treasurer, for all the work she did to coordinate the recent on-line auction. Thanks also go to Bryan Cook, Shannon Sizer, and Tony Jeffries for all the help they provided Cheryl.

Chapter elections will take place at the May meeting. Open positions are vice-president, treasurer, and four board members. Any one wanting to run for a position or to nominate someone, please contact Peg Morris and Andy Bodeen.

2021 Scholarship deadline is May 7th. The one change in the application this year is the inclusion of currently enrolled higher education students who meet the residency criteria.

The evening's speaker was David Craig, high school trap coach from Newberg. It was learned that nationally there are 30,000 young people shooting on trap teams in 26 states. In Oregon, there are 50 high schools with trap teams. Yamhill County has 3 teams – Newberg, Amity, and Yamhill-Carlton. These three teams have a total participation of 83. A representative from each team also spoke.

Following the trap team presentation, each team was presented a donation check from the chapter. The board earlier approved a total \$2500, which was divided among the three teams according to the number of participants on each team.

With no other business on the agenda, the meeting was adjourned. The next general meeting will be held on May 13th, 7:00 PM, at the American Legion Post in McMinnville.
