Clinic Corner by Arika Hoyt

I would like to introduce a new section of the FL NAWGJ newsletter known as the **Clinic Corner**. Now let's talk Xcel Casts - "A cast within 10° of the requirement will receive VP/SR credit."

Required Technique for the Recognition VPs. 2.b (p. 12 uneven bars/electronic code)

This is a new deduction/rule introduced for the 2022-2023 competitive season. If gymnast performs a cast between 1°-9° below the level required cast angle, the Special Requirement is awarded and a flat .10 is deducted from the cast. This deduction should only be applied once in a routine and only for the cast counting for VP. If the gymnast later performs a cast at or above the required angle the flat .10 is no longer deducted from the previous cast. Likewise, if the gymnast never performs a cast throughout the routine that achieves the required angel within 10°, the flat .10 would not be deducted, instead deduct .50 from Start Value for missing Special Requirement.

* Execution errors (body position, arms, legs...) will be deducted on all casts regardless of angle.

Helpful Hint: Print Cast Chart on page 12 of Electronic Code and have it out on the table as a reference as to what each angle looks like.

If your U101: Safety and Risk Management Course Certification is Expiring on 7/31/23...

Individuals are able to renew their U101: Safety and Risk Management course certification up to six months prior to their expiration date. This will extend your certification date four years from the year it is set to expire.
