

# Making the Right Detours: Choosing God's Path Over Wrong Turns

### Why Do We Need to Make Spiritual Detours?

- Activities that please the flesh rather than the spirit
- Unforgiveness and bitterness
- Compromise of our values
- Idolatry (putting anything before God)
- Situations that lead to sin

- Love
- Hope
- Peace
- Integrity
- Wisdom
- Forgiveness

## **How Does God Help Us Stay on the Right Path?**

- While God won't force our decisions, He:
- Provides warning signs
- Gives us wisdom to make right choices
- Offers ways of escape from temptation
- Sends the Holy Spirit to guide us
- Blesses our obedience
- Strengthens us when we choose right

## Life Application

This week, challenge yourself to:

- Identify the "Road Closed" signs God has placed in your life
- Make conscious decisions to detour away from harmful situations
- Choose God's path even when it seems less exciting
- Trust that God's detours lead to better destinations

# Ask yourself:

What warning signs am I currently ignoring?

What relationships or activities do I need to detour away from?

Am I truly trusting God's path for my life?

How can I be more intentional about following God's guidance?
