Our mission of the quarter is the Child Advocacy Center in Whiteville. As part of the Boys and Girls Home, this non-profit center provides an essential service for not only Columbus County but also surrounding counties. The CAC team meets with child victims and non-offending caregivers to help heal children from the traumas of abuse. They provide forensic interviews for child and youth victims, comprehensive medical evaluations, family and child advocacy, trauma focused therapy, and language translations for children and adults related to CAC services provided.

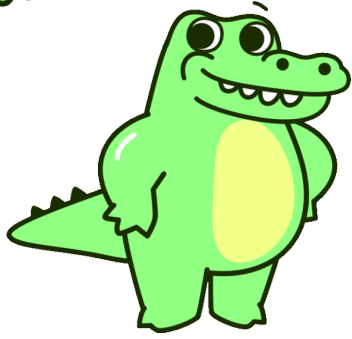
