Chrismons

Chrismons were first made by Frances Spencer at Ascension Lutheran Church in Danville, Virginia in 1957. Mrs. Spencer was trying to figure out how to have ornaments for the church Christmas tree that would reflect the Christian faith instead of using random ornaments like we might use on our trees at home. She wanted ornaments with deep, spiritual meaning.



She settled on limiting the ornament colors to just two: gold to represent the majesty and glory of Jesus and then white to represent our joy and His purity and His perfection. Rather than using the English name, Jesus, and calling these decorations "Jesus ornaments", she used the Greek word for Jesus.... "Christos" representing His name. Chrismon means "Christ's monogram".

In our church, we decorate our tree with Chrismons, lovingly prepared by the women of our church, many who have left their handiwork as a memory. Each Chrismon is a symbol of Christ. Some use Greek letters that spell His name; others symbolize the various roles that He played in fulfilling scripture. When we look at the beautiful Chrismons, let us remember majesty, glory, purity, perfection, and joy.
