If alterations are made prior to ACC approval I may be required to return the property to its former condition at my own expense, and I may be required to pay all legal expenses incurred if legal action becomes necessary.
- 3. I understand that the members of the ACC are permitted to enter my property to make reasonable inspection of the proposed construction location.
- 4. I am aware of the Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions and Design Guidelines contained in the Kensington CCRs and any and all communications from the Kensington HOA related to the CCRs and Design Guidelines.
- 5. The alteration authority granted by this application may be revoked automatically if the alteration requested is not commenced within six (6) months from the date of approval of this Application and/or has not been substantially completed within twelve (12) months from the date of approval of this Application
- 6. I understand any approval is contingent upon construction or alterations being completed in a workmanlike manner.
- 7. I understand that if I disagree with the ACC ruling, an appeals procedure is available by notifying the ACC in writing and requesting a review of the ruling.
- 8. I understand that the ACC reserves the right to require a deposit for any fees charged by professional consultants or agencies used by the ACC to process my application and that I will be notified by the ACC in writing of any fees prior to the processing of this application.
