Purpose

The Paul Bernot Memorial Foundation Scholarship was established in 2018. The mission of this foundation is to empower athletes, of any skill level, impacted by cancer to pursue their passions. One specific goal of the foundation is to establish and maintain a scholarship in Paul's honor. This scholarship will help to provide financial assistance to a student who is a legal resident of the United States of America, is pursuing post high school education, is passionate about sports, athletics, and/or physical fitness, and who is currently or has previously been diagnosed with/treated for cancer. Scholarship Award Evaluation

The Paul Bernot Memorial Foundation will award the scholarship(s) based on a complete review of all applicants' merits. Areas that are reviewed by the committee include, but are not limited to, the following: Fully meeting all criteria, academic accomplishments, personal essay, community service/leadership, and reference letter. Scholarship funds are paid directly to the institution where the student is enrolled. Proof of current or prior diagnosis/treatment of cancer is required.

Applicant Criteria

- Applicants must submit the Physician Verification form for proof of current or prior diagnosis/treatment of cancer. This form is to be completed by the Primary Care Physician or Oncologist.
- Applicants must be completing or have completed high school successfully with a minimum unweighted GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.
- Applicants must be accepted and enrolled as a student in at least 2 classes (typically 6 credit hours)
 at an accredited college, university, or trade school in the United States for the Fall 2019 academic
 semester.
- Applicants must complete and submit a Scholarship Application postmarked by June 15, 2019.
- Applicants must complete an essay (up to 500 words) explaining "How I will represent and/or carry out the mission of the Foundation: to empower athletes impacted by cancer to pursue their passions."

*Please note, although you do not need to be a high school or college athlete to apply, the essay should help to paint a picture of the role that sports and/or physical fitness play in your life.

- Applicants, if being awarded a scholarship, will be notified by June 30, 2019.
