



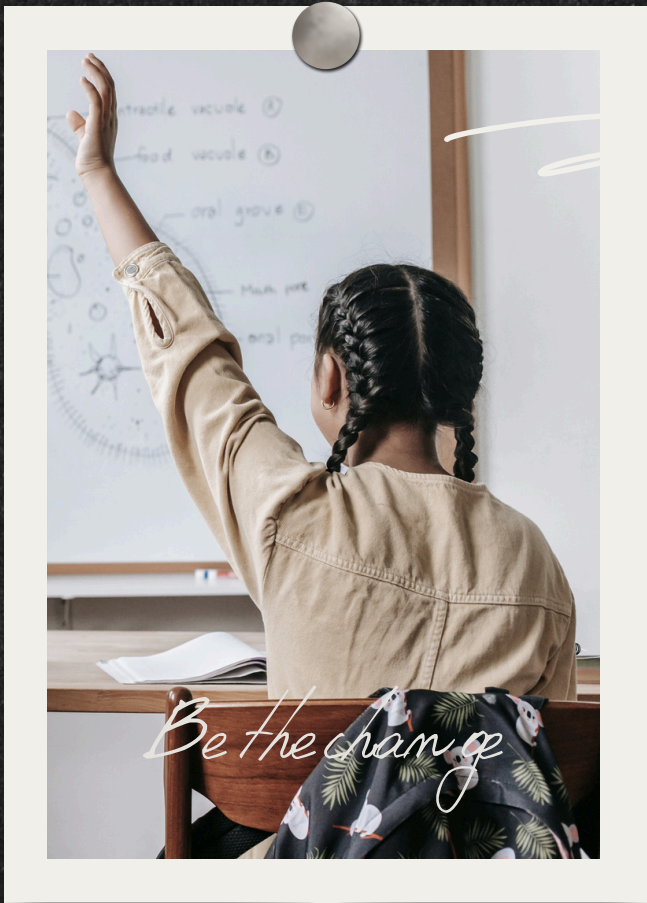
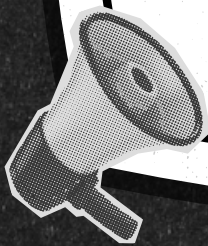

In your highest imagination, what do you hope our world will become? How do you show up within your vision?

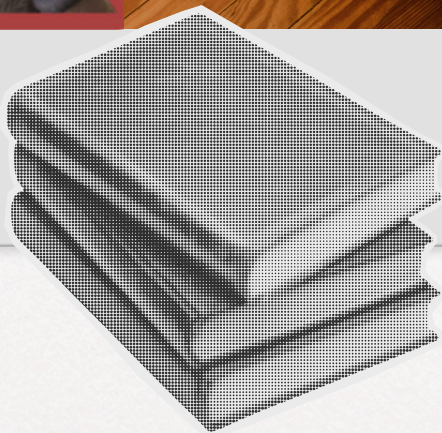
