Parent Commitments & Expectations

- I will support my child's enjoyment of soccer by encouraging effort, teamwork, and positive attitudes.
- I will show respect toward all TCU YSA coaches, referees, players, families, and volunteers.
- I will let coaches coach, referees officiate, and players play.
- I will not engage in negative sideline behavior, criticism, yelling at referees, or coaching from the sidelines.
- I will model self-control and sportsmanship at all TCUYSA events.
- I will ensure my child arrives on time and prepared for practices and games.
- I will communicate schedule conflicts with the coach at least 48 hours in advance when possible.
- I will encourage my child to follow the TCU YSA Player Code of Conduct.
- I understand TCU YSA's zero tolerance policies regarding bullying, harassment, and substance use.
- I will cheer positively and avoid negative or distracting behavior.
- I will not challenge or confront referees, players, coaches, or other spectators.
- I will respect all TCU YSA facility rules and help keep fields clean.
- I understand that my behavior can affect my child's playing time or eligibility if it violates TCU YSA standards.
- If I am upset by something I will wait 24hrs before discussing the issue with the team coach and will do so in a private and constructive manner.
