Official Player Code of Conduct

As a registered player with the Tri-City United Youth Soccer Association (TCUYSA), I commit to representing our club with integrity, respect, and sportsmanship at all times. I understand that I am an ambassador of Tri-City United Soccer, and my actions reflect directly on our club, community, and teammates.

TCU YSA Values: Respect, Sportsmanship & Character

- I will play soccer because I want to, and for my enjoyment and growth.
- I will follow the laws of the game and honor the spirit of TCUYSA youth soccer.
- I will show respect to all TCUYSA coaches, referees, teammates, opponents, club officials, and spectators.
- I will control my temper and will not engage in fighting, taunting, foul language, or inappropriate gestures.
- I will demonstrate positive teamwork and support my teammates.
- I understand that success in TCUYSA is not only about winning—fun, effort, skill development, friendship, and sportsmanship are equally important.
- I will recognize good play from both my team and the opposing team.
- I understand that TCUYSA coaches coach soccer, not behavior; improper behavior may result in removal from the field or event.
- I will not attend any TCU YSA practice, game, or event under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
- I will not participate in bullying in any form—verbal, physical, or online/social media.
- I understand that TCUYSA has zero tolerance for bullying.

TCU YSA Expectations for Games & Practices

- I understand that practices are vital to my growth as a TCUYSA player.
- I will arrive on time for practices and games, following my coach's expectations.
- If I must miss a practice or game, I will notify my TCUYSA coach at least 48 hours in advance
- whenever possible.
- I recognize that attendance, attitude, effort, and team needs may determine playing time and starting roles.
- I will silence and put away electronic devices before arriving at TCUYSA practices, games, and team events.
- I understand that playing time varies:
 - • Competitive (travel) teams may use an earned playing time system.
 - • Recreation & Development (U10 and under) strive for equitable playing time.
- I will help keep TCUYSA fields, facilities, and sidelines clean and free of trash.

TCU YSA Disciplinary Action

If I fail to uphold the TCUYSA Player Code of Conduct, any of the following actions may be taken by my coach or the club:

- Reduction of playing time
- Temporary suspension from practices, games, or events
- Removal from the team
