Dimensions Sciences College Ambassador Program in the US

Scientific inventions and medical advancements rely on the sharing of ideas from all peoples to solve critical world problems.

Dimensions Sciences' mission is to promote inclusion and diversity among aspiring scientists and doctors.

Goals: *DS-A program aims to provide a platform for sharing ideas, networking among peers and scientific professionals, as well as for the creation of opportunities that promote diversity and professional growth.*

Action item: We are looking for student leaders of science-related, medicine-related, Latin American-related, diversity-related or similar clubs on college or university campuses to share our mission and promote diversity among the sciences. Ambassadors may be part of a previous existing club or newly formed group of interested individuals on a higher-education campus.

To become a DS Ambassador, individuals / clubs will be asked to plan and complete at least 1 of the DS-A responsibilities (see below) within the school year. In return, Ambassadors have the opportunity to be recognized for their efforts through DS's social media outlets and/or online newsletter and will have access to DS organized events and public forums (see below for examples). To provide information pertinent for our Ambassadors, we encourage DS-A's to suggest content ideas for workshops and webinars at the start of every semester.

DS-A responsibilities (choose at least 1)

1. Volunteer or organize a community-based science event that promotes inclusion and diversity (i.e. ethnic, cultural, racial, religious, gender etc.)
Examples: After-school programs or a Science fair/ competition that fosters opportunities for underrepresented groups in the sciences
2. Fundraise for one or more of [Dimensions Sciences scholarship programs](#)
Examples: 'Science is beautiful' art contest or virtual science fair that promotes diversity
3. Disseminate information about Dimensions Sciences sponsored events across campus.
Examples: Fliers on campus, social media sharing, club watching events

DS-A Webinars and workshops (available at least 2x a semester)
