

How to apply

Applications must be submitted through a **digital form** provided at: **Bridges Scholarship** page.

Email submissions will not be considered.

You will be asked to:

- 1. Identify your Inclusion Eligibility Criteria.
- 2. Provide Basic Information (Name, address, date of birth, institution, education).
- 3. Identify area of research: Life Sciences, Healthcare or other.
- 4. Provide link of the CV Lattes of the candidate.
- 5. Provide link of the C.V. Lattes from the project manager or head of the laboratory (PI, principal investigator).
- 6. Provide recommendation letter of the Principal Investigator (PI) linked to the project.
- 7. Provide Institutional Consent Letter Supporting the project.
- 8. Upload Project Description (in Portuguese or English, PDF format), containing: 1. Project summary: introduction, material, and methods, expected results and discussion (250 words). 2. Potential for scientific, economic and/or social impact: Includes context, benefited community, quantifiable goals, and milestones (250 words). 3. Feasibility: What exactly do you intend to do during the scholarship period? Includes a schedule of activities for the grant period (250 words). 4. Competitive scenario: how do you describe the competitive scenario of your scientific and/or technological proposal? (250 words) 5. Does the institution offer the appropriate resources for the realization of your project? Describe the resources of the host institution that will allow the project to be carried out (facilities, equipment, personnel, etc.). (250 words).
- 9. Provide link on You Tube of a short video of the candidate presenting his



personal and professional history, the reasons that led him to participate in the project in question and his expectations about how this participation will impact his professional life. Guidelines (videos will be part of the selection process): 1. Total duration: maximum of 3 minutes. 2. Language: Portuguese or English. 3. Presentation: The candidate must appear in the video (no narrated slides or animations will be considered). 4. The video should contain: the candidate's personal trajectory (including narration on whether and how one or more aspects of the eligibility criteria impacted his trajectory), presentation of the project, expected impact on the life of the candidates. 5. The video must be uploaded via YouTube link.
