



How to apply- Checklist

Applications open on June 9th, 2025 at 12:00 AM ET

Deadline on August 4, 2025 at 12:00 AM ET

Applications will only be accepted through a digital form to be provided at <https://dimensionssciences.org/scientista-award>

Email submissions **will not be** considered.

You will be asked to:

- 1- Identify your name and last name
- 2- Identify your Institution and which state you work in the US
- 3- Identify your gender
- 4- Identify your citizenship
- 5- Identify the area of your research

You will have to upload:

- 1- Upload your CV (.pdf)
- 2- Upload a copy of valid Brazilian passport (.pdf)
- 3- Upload a copy of the PhD Diploma (.pdf)
- 4- Upload a letter of recommendation supporting your application from a senior scientist or supervisor (.pdf)
- 5- Upload a letter with the institution letterhead with authorized signature confirming the candidate holds postdoctoral, research associate, instructor position, or equivalent in a research institution in academia or industry in the

scientistA

US (.pdf). Upload in the “Letter of recommendation” section together with the recommendation letter.

6- Upload impact statement addressing the 3 sections below (10 points).

Please note: 500 words limit per section, total 1500 words.

A. Project scientific abstract: Include background, materials and methods, expected results and discussion (3 points).

B. Project impact: How does your project impact people? Include problem, solution, and quantifiable results (4 points).

C. Project innovation: How would you describe the project innovation (3 points)?

7- Upload a link of the candidate's video containing (10 points):

A. Personal trajectory,

B. Presentation of the project,

C. Expected impact on the candidate's life.

Please note: Candidates must appear in the video (narrated slide show or animations will not be considered).

Language: English or Portuguese with subtitles in English.

Total Duration: up to 3 minutes (Videos longer than 3 min will not be accepted)

Acceptable formats: Link to Google Drive or YouTube. The video link must be shared with public access enabled.
