THE OCTOBER CAMBRIDGE NEWS

1. The Board made a final decision on a management company, voting to switch from Vista to Leland Management as of January 1, 2026. The unanimous vote of the Board clearly expresses the expectation the Leland will serve us well.
2. The Cambridge Board agreed to participate in the Kings Ridge garage sale on October 11th from 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. The master board has decided to have the gate at Kings Ridge Blvd and Hancock Road open for the sale.
3. The Board has nominated Marty Martin, its current representative on the master board, to serve another one-year term. Nominations for other candidates will be held at either the October or November meeting.
4. Because of concerns about the contracts for cable/tv coverage from Fiber Now (Opticaltel) and Spectrum, the budget committee has postponed action on the 2026 budget until next month. We have received a proposed amendment to the Spectrum contract from our attorney that would protect us from the possibility of double billing before the switch-over from Fiber Now to Spectrum.
