Treasurer's Report 9-2-2025

The following is confirmed by current Bank OZK account info, Moneyspire accounting program, and the Budget Summary.

All bills for August have been paid with the addition of \$160.00 paid to Kenny Poe for the Service Call and Freight costs for the replacement of the failed circuit board for the exit gates. All gate repairs show the repairs were effective.

Landscape and Architectural Report: It appears as landscaping is going on schedule.

With the rains that fell in August, our yards are looking great. Routine drain maintenance was performed on the detention pond. It appears that we may have to replace the filter gravel in the future due to sediment migration occluding the gravel's water flow.

The Board received a request from Karl Stocker to add a Pergola over his back patio slab.

The Board approved request by 5 attending board members.

Activity Report: Chair exercise continuing with new programs. Game Day continuing on 2nd Tuesday of each month at 1:00pm, Game Night has been cancelled until later in the fall, Ladies Luncheon will be at Millhouse Station in Pendergrass on Friday, September 19th at 11:30am.

Hospitality Report: No new residents to greet; however, the Bailey home has a contract tentatively scheduled to close October 1st. The buyer is named as Gabriele Beyer.

Old Business:

- 1. The failure of the gates was related to the circuit board indicating a motor overload. Kenny Poe conducted the trouble shooting process to discover the cause. It was determined that with the help of the manufacturer that the circuit board located in the right-hand exit gate had a circuit failure which prevented the motor from functioning. Kenny removed the circuit board and sent it to the manufacturer in California. That process took five days and the manufacturer sent a new board to Kenny that took an additional five days. Counting the 10 days of shipping and the two weekends, the repair took 14 days to complete. Bill Connell replaced the 4 dead batteries in the exit gate controllers. All tests and functions are normal as of 8-26-25.
- During last month's meeting, Rita Arritt voiced her concerns over the increased traffic on Camellia Lane and the lower end of Lakeview Bend Cir. Since then, Bill Connell received an email from Penny Griffin expressing the same concerns. In addition, he has received two verbal complaints expressing the same concerns.

These concerns are a result of the Estates' deciding to continuously close their gates indefinitely. The problem is not residential traffic; but, directly related to commercial traffic. It has been noted that contractors have been using our entrance routinely and avoiding the Estates' entrance all together. One gray pickup truck working on Lillian Way has been observed traveling back and forth up to 4-5 times a day on week days. Several other vehicles have been noted traveling back



and forth as well. It is estimated that 30-40% of the pass-through traffic are not residents.

The Board needs to discuss revisiting a 60-day trial of closing our gates on a 24hour basis to eliminate this issue. This will require a vote of the membership to take any action.

The Board will prepare and send out ballots within 24-48 hours regarding changing gate timing.

NEW Business:

- The Board shall discuss the schedule for the nomination and election of the required selection of the following officers:
 - a) Secretary
 - b) Treasurer
 - c) Hospitality Director
 - d) Activities Director

The process begins with the Nomination of these positions beginning in mid-September. After receiving the nominations, the Board will prepare Ballots to be sent out during the first week or so in October. The ballots will be counted in the last weeks of October. The announcement of the elections will occur at or near the next board meeting on the First Tuesday of November.

All nominees should be capable of providing a minimum of 2 years of service for those positions and have the needed computer equipment and software to perform their duties. Some of these positions will require more involvement than others.
