

ABOUT THE HAZARDOUS WASTE COLLECTION CENTER (HWCC)

Unwanted household chemicals, automotive fluids, pharmaceuticals, and various hazardous materials, substances or products can be toxic to the public and pose a threat to the environment if improperly discarded or placed in the trash.

DON'T SEND IT TO THE LANDFILL! BRING IT TO US AT THE HWCC.

The Alachua County Environmental Protection Department provides a free countywide service for the proper management of hazardous and toxic materials and waste for Alachua County residents. The vast majority of waste is recycled. The waste that cannot be recycled is either neutralized or sent to a hazardous waste incinerator for proper disposal.
