

New Zion Library Books for September 2025





COUNCIL NEWS

Summary of Congregation Council Minutes – July 8, 2025

(The full minutes are posted on the bulletin board near the church office.)

Membership Update: Kristi Montgomery shared the Statistical Report for June. Total weekend attendance YTD is 3,784. The average weekend worship attendance YTD is 140. Kristi Montgomery made a motion to accept the membership of Sarah Greenwalt with Deb Willwerth seconding the motion. All ayes

Treasurer's Report: Treasurer, Deb Vath,reported that our Income is down for the month compared to the budget as are our Expenses. YTD we have a negative balance of (\$6,599.49). Deb reported that our insurance cost with Church Mutual has increased by 33%. Deb Vath reported to the Council that the purchase of the Personal Computer for the office was made with funds from the Office Equipment Reserve line item. Pastor Julie moved to accept the Treasurer's report. Linda Dutchess seconded the motion. All ayes.

Old Business:

Call Committee Report: Pastor Julie reported to the Council that there has been one candidate's name given to the committee. An interview with the individual will be scheduled within the next two weeks.

Interim Planning: Two pastors are willing to work in the interim. They are Pastor Paul Holmer and Pastor Barbara Hayden. The duties that need to be performed by our Interim Pastors and the division of these duties were shared with the Council. Compensation for Pastor Hayden and Pastor Holmer was reviewed. A motion was brought to the Council by the Executive committee asking the Council to approve the contracts for both Interim Pastors (Hayden and Holmer). The full Council unanimously approved the motion. The Council reviewed the Housing Allowance for Pastor Hayden. The amount of the Housing Allowance was unanimously accepted by the Council.

Scholarship Committee: Kristi Montgomery reported that there are 9 applicants that have applied for a scholarship. The amount of the scholarships is \$1,200 (\$600 for each semester) for the year. The applicants are: Kaylee Camp, Sarah Hilgendorf, Avery Luett, Payton Luett, Elijah Luett, Emeree Luett, Elizabeth Morehead, Alyssa Schroeder and Randy Spensley. Committee funding was discussed. A motion and second to approve all applicants was unanimous.

"Caring for Our Community" Support: Pastor Julie reported that there are 15 volunteers for this ministry. Training for the volunteers is being done. There are approximately 35 recipients currently that may want a visit with others still to be identified. Deb Willwerth has volunteered to lead this ministry.

Technology Committee: Erin Montgomery reported to the Council that there has been only one response to her request for members to join this committee. The committee will meet again in August with an additional member to be recruited.
