Dec. 11, 1933 - Charles Heimerdinger, veteran employee of the Consumers Power company and believed to have been one of the most successful gardeners in the city, is confined to his home, 211 North Street, with a severe illness. Mr. Heimerdinger. one of the pioneers of Ingham county and for many years a resident of Lansing, demonstrated what can be done in vegetable and food production on supposedly waste and sterile land. A number of years ago the Consumers Power company, which owns



considerable land north of West Willow Street along Grand River, filled in a number of low places. The fill was accomplished with dirt excavated from basements and with other refuse from the plant. On this filled land the company dumped residue from byproducts of gas manufacture which was rich in nitrates, Mr. Heimerdinger called attention to the fact that this ground would produce much foodstuff. Company officials kidded the Lansing pioneer and classed him with the weather forecasters. But permission was given to Mr. Heimerdinger to go ahead if he cared to experiment. Several offered to eat all at one sitting anything he grew on the land. But the Lansing pioneer knew his business. He fitted the land, which was a tough job, and then planted his vegetables. Corn, beans, carrots, parsnips, in fact all the Michigan garden vegetables soon began to sprout. Mr. Heimerdinger cultivated his crop himself. Time did the rest. And the vegetables he produced and continued to produce on his plot scandalized the scoffers. Many who have seen the Heimerdinger garden and who partook of its excellent produce, claim there was never another garden like it in the city. And so waste land was brought into bearing and Mr. Heimerdinger demonstrated what can be done with poor soil properly fertilized.

Charles J. Heimerdinger, 80, pioneer resident of Lansing, who was born in 1853 on the site of the present Hotel Downey, died Monday Feb. 26, 1934 at his home, 211 West North Street. He was believed to have been Lansing's oldest native-born resident, and would have been 81 March 22. Mr. Heimerdinger's father, John, owned and operated a general store on Turner Street in North Lansing, in the days when it was necessary to make trips to Detroit by horse and wagon for provisions. Mr. Heimerdinger vividly remembered these early trips, when two weeks was required to go to Detroit and return. There were no railroads in Lansing at that time, and the only through highways were toll roads of corduroy construction. His father helped cut the timber and lay the first corduroy road from uptown, which was then called "Middletown," to North Lansing. Mr. Heimerdinger could recall the time when game, principally deer and black squirrels, abounded in the woods where the greater part of Lansing is now. Most of Mr. Heimerdinger's early life was spent in farming west of Lansing, and he lived at Haslett for several years. He returned to Lansing in 1914 and was in the employ of the Consumers Power company until last June when he was taken ill.

He is survived by one daughter, Miss Esther Heimerdinger of Lansing, a son, Charles of Chicago; three sisters, Mrs. Ann Everett of Haslett, Mrs. of Detroit and Miss and two grandsons, Arthur Mauk and Heimerdinger, Jr.

He was a member of the Lutheran church, services will be held Wednesday at 10:30 a. m., from the Estes-Funeral home, the Rev. Phillip Schroeder of Trinity Lutheran Church, Detroit, officiating. Interment will be in Mt. Hope Cemetery.

Chris Heimerdinger, President at Heimerdinger Entertainment. Heimerdinger first started publishing books in 1989 with Tennis Shoes Among the Nephites, based on events in the Book of Mormon. This and the nine books which followed in the Tennis Shoes Adventure Series are among Heimerdinger's most popular books.

Heimerdinger also wrote several books which are not part of the Tennis Shoes Adventure Series. These include Eddie Fantastic, a science fiction tale set in modern Salt Lake City; Daniel and Nephi, an adventure novel set in 600 B.C. Israel that speculates that the prophets Daniel and Nephi may have known one another as children; Ben Franklin and the Chamber of Time, a time-travel adventure; A Return to Christmas, a story about the reunion of twins separated as young boys; and A Light in the Storm, about a man stranded in a blizzard in the mountains of Montana.

In 2005, Heimerdinger also embarked upon his lifelong dream of directing movies and began production of Passage to Zarahemla. The project was born of an original screenplay written in 1999 called "Summer of the Nephite" and was published as a novel, Passage to Zarahemla in 2003. The film was completed and released in theatres on October 12, 2007. This movie, with 185 special effects shots, "features the most special effects of any LDS-themed film to date". It was recently released on DVD in June 2008.

Heimerdinger also composed nine songs for his motion picture, and released the album, Whispered Visions: Songs from the Motion Picture Passage to Zarahemla in 2008. On this album, Heimerdinger sings most of the songs. His back-up vocalists include renowned talents such as Jessie Clark Funk and Katherine Nelson. Other back-up vocalists include Kenneth Cope, Alex Boye, Barry Givens, Jim Funk, Felicia Wolfe, Tanya Barkdall, Jarrod Haddock, and Daniel Beck. The first three cuts on the album were co-produced with Tommy Hopkins, while the remainder were co-produced with Jim Funk.

Chris Heimerdinger (born August 26, 1963) is an American author who has written twenty novels for adults and young adults, most famously the Tennis Shoes Adventure Series. He is a member of The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints (LDS Church), and most of his stories center on religious themes familiar to Latter-day Saints. Heimerdinger was born in Bloomington, Indiana. His father was a

professor in theatre at Indiana University. His parents divorced when he was four years old and his mother remarried. Heimerdinger has one older brother and two younger sisters. Heimerdinger excelled in Wyoming High School competitions for three years in the categories of Humor, Oratory, and Drama. He began to write books at the age of 7, and continued through high school. He also began making super-8 films beginning in junior high, and showed these films to the scholarship committee of Brigham Young University in 1981, earning a full scholarship in 'Theatre and Cinematic Arts' after receiving a Sundance Institute 'Most Promising Filmmaker' award for his film Night Meeting. Heimerdinger read the Book of Mormon at age 18, during his first semester at college, and was converted to the Mormon faith on Oct 10, 1981.

Heimerdinger is the author of the Tennis Shoes Adventure Series. His first published work was Tennis Shoes Among the Nephites (1989), based on events in the Book of Mormon. Thus far twelve books have followed in the series, the first of which features three children who discover a secret cave capable of transporting its visitors back in time. The following books continue with the original characters as they go to college, get married, and have kids. The characters also have to deal with death, parenting troubles and time travel. The first books in the series were intended to be a fictional account of the Book of Mormon, while later ones explore other historical eras, including Ancient Rome, Israel during the Roman destruction in A.D. 73, and the time period of the Tower of Babel. The last four novels in this series include research notes at the end of each chapter.

In 2005, Heimerdinger began production of Passage to Zarahemla. Originally written in 1999 as a screenplay entitled "Summer of the Nephite" it was published as a novel, Passage to Zarahemla in 2003. The film was released to cinemas in October 2007 and as of 2011 ranks in the top 100 for both Christian and Fantasy Live-Action films. It was released on DVD in June 2008. In August 2011, a book sequel to Passage to Zarahemla, entitled Escape From Zarahemla was released by Covenant Communications, Inc. A self-published novel, Muckwhip's Guide to Capturing the Latter-day Soul, was released as an ebook in November 2012 and as a paperback in December 2012.

In 2008 Heimerdinger was among the top 10 list of LDS authors as chosen by Mormon Times readers. Heimerdinger utilizes the title of his Tennis Shoes Adventure Series in helping around the world. In August 2005 Heimerdinger joined with Hearts and Hands for Humanity in American Fork, Utah to help collect tennis shoes for children 5 to 12 years old. In 2007 Heimerdinger again joined with Hearts and Hands for Humanity to collect tennis shoes. This time it was in honor of a dead soldier, Nathan Barnes, of American Fork, Utah. The goal this time was to collect and send thousands of tennis shoes to Iraq.

Oct 14, 2007 - LDS author takes flying leap into filmmaking with "Passage to Zarahemla". Chris Heimerdinger, the best-selling author of the "Tennis Shoes Among the Nephites" books, likes every "Mormon" movie he sees -- except for the ones that are, not to put too fine a point on it, bad. So which ones are the bad ones? "I think the last really strong LDS film we had was 'Saints and Soldiers,'" Heimerdinger said. Theatrical release date: Aug. 6, 2004. Heimerdinger temporarily traded in his keyboard for a clapboard as co-writer and director of "Passage to Zarahemla," which opened Friday at theaters along the Wasatch Front. The author-turned-auteur isn't down on every film targeted to moviegoing members of The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints that's been released since mid-2004. He's just connecting the dots.

"The reason Latter-day Saints are not going to LDS movies is not because they don't want to go to LDS movies," Heimerdinger said. "They don't want to go to bad LDS movies." Some LDS films, like "The Book of Mormon Movie," are more or less instantly forgettable. Yet audiences have mostly spurned "Beauty and the Beast: A Latter-day Tale," "Return with Honor," "The Dance," "Picadilly Cowboy" aka "Anxiously Engaged," "Believe" and "Turn Around" already this year. Were all of them bad? And, more to the point, is "Passage to Zarahemla" any good? Without even seeing it, Salt Lake Tribune Culture Vulture columnist Brandon Griggs dismissed that possibility out-of-hand in a recent column. In an opinion piece printed in the Daily Herald in April, Heimerdinger chided LDS filmmakers for watering down the LDS-specific content of their films: "If you're gonna make a Mormon movie, make a Mormon movie! Don't apologize for it!" Recalling that sentiment, Griggs wrote, "No, Chris, apologize instead for making a bad movie."

Heimerdinger called Griggs's diss "incredible," but said that he understands that moviegoers have low expectations. "We have to recognize," he said, "that that truly is the way that people have come to perceive LDS films." "Passage to Zarahemla" was made for "around \$1 million" -- most Mormon movies

are in that ballpark, though some are made at considerably lesser cost, whereas Hollywood films can gobble up anywhere from \$10 million to \$100 million or more (much, much more in some cases) -- but Heimerdinger is confident that people will like what they see. "I don't believe I could have delivered a better project for the budget that we spent on this film," he said. "I think probably it will go down as being the most entertaining celebration of the Book of Mormon that's ever been put on film. Period."

Long road to "Passage". If "Passage to Zarahemla" doesn't deliver on that level, then it won't be for lack of effort, and not just on Heimerdinger's part. The star of the movie is Summer Naomi Smart, a Brigham Young University graduate who made her entrance into LDS film in March as the star of "Beauty and the Beast: A Latter-day Tale." Smart, 25, who's currently in the Chicago cast of the Broadway play "Wicked," said she started out filming "Passage to Zarahemla" while simultaneously acting in two plays at St. George's Tuacahn Amphitheatre. "It probably wasn't the sanest thing," she said. "I had never done film before; I didn't realize what the hours would be." The strain of being at Tuacahn until midnight and then starting in on "Passage to Zarahemla" every morning before 6 a.m. was so great that Smart initially backed out of the film.

"We went to Hollywood and did auditions," Heimerdinger said. After personally seeing several dozen of about 600 auditions, he knew his first instinct had been right. "None of them could hold a candle to Summer," he said. "I called her from California and begged her. I said, 'We'll make any sacrifice necessary.' " That's been the attitude of Heimerdinger, who lives in Draper, for a while, actually. The 44-year-old storyteller, who has five kids, has wanted to make a movie ever since studying film at BYU for three years before dropping out short of graduation. "I left school because I was basically broke and needed money," he said. "My intention was always to go back to BYU and finish my degree."

Instead, Heimerdinger ended up spending a few years in the nine-to-five workplace and was working as a telemarketer when he wrote "Tennis Shoes Among the Nephites," about Wyoming kids who discover a time-space portal to Book of Mormon lands ... and discovered an entirely different career. It's been 18 years (and nine more "Tennis Shoes" titles, plus several other novels) since his publication breakthrough, but the accidental novelist has never lost his desire to jump into filmmaking. There's also a "Passage to Zarahemla" novel that was published in 2003, but the book only exists because Heimerdinger wasn't, at the time, having any luck getting backers for his "Passage" screenplay, originally titled "Summer of the Nephite." When he published "Passage to Zarahemla," he put the words "Soon to be a major motion picture" on the cover. "We hadn't raised a single dime" at that point, Heimerdinger said. "But I was determined enough that I put that on the cover of the book." The fires (literally) of adversity

Heimerdinger eventually partnered with Orem-based Candlelight Media Group. Candlelight's Brian Brough, a producer on "Passage to Zarahemla," said that the author's notoriety helped convince the company to work with him. "Chris Heimerdinger has a name," Brough said, "and it's nice to work on a project that you know will have a following." Brough said that he was also won over by "Passage to Zarahemla's" uniqueness. There have been lots of different LDS films, but none that you could even tangentially slot into the epic fantasy adventure genre. That explains why Brough and other backers were willing to make a bet on Heimerdinger.

Despite upheaval in his personal life over the period between the start of filming and theatrical release -- including the breakup of Heimerdinger's nearly 20-year marriage to his wife, Beth, and legal troubles -- Heimerdinger's own belief in himself was reinforced by events during filming that he described as being miraculous. A great deal of the film was shot on a private farm in tiny Leeds, near St. George. Heimerdinger said that a technician operating a smoker, or fog blower, inadvertently started a brush fire during filming that threatened to burn down both the farm and the woods around it where the movie was being filmed. The accident didn't occur, however, until mere hours after filming in the woods burned by the fire was completed. And the flames, Heimerdinger said, "stopped within 10 yards" of the farmhouse and surrounding buildings.

It could take a miracle for "Passage" to turn a profit. The most recent LDS film, "Return with Honor," lasted a month in theaters and didn't quite crack \$100,000 in tickets sold. "Passage to Zarahemla" would probably need to gross five or six times that amount just to have a shot at breaking even with strong DVD and foreign sales. The Larry H. Miller-backed "The Work and the Glory III: A House Divided" managed, impressively, to hang around in theaters for a little more than five months. Its final box-office tallyfi A meager \$1.3 million.

Worrisomefi Of course. Heimerdinger thinks that the "Passage" special effects will be the best ever seen in an LDS film, however, and said that he's expecting strong word-of-mouth: "People, over the weekend



(after the film's opening), they'll be saying, 'Here's a real good one. I was shocked.' " One of the theaters that will be showing the film locally is Orem's SCERA Showhouse. SCERA CEO Adam Robertson said that LDS films have done well for the SCERA in the past and that he expects more of the same from "Passage to Zarahemla." "We're interested in it because it's a local film," Robertson said, and because it espouses "family-friendly" values. "People expect to see those types of shows here." Smart said that she thinks there's still plenty of room for LDS films to grow. But she said that "Passage to Zarahemla" shows that there's still ample reason to hope for the genre: "I think we've got a good start."
